Description: Mindomo is a free online mind-mapping tool; allowing you to organize ideas and thoughts, plan and track projects, define goals and objectives, manage tasks and priorities, all within the browser.

System Requirements: Flash Player 9 or above, Firefox, Safari, Internet Explorer or Chrome web browser.

Signup Requirements: You will need to register for an account, which is free, on wetoku.com. You will need to create a username and enter a valid email address.

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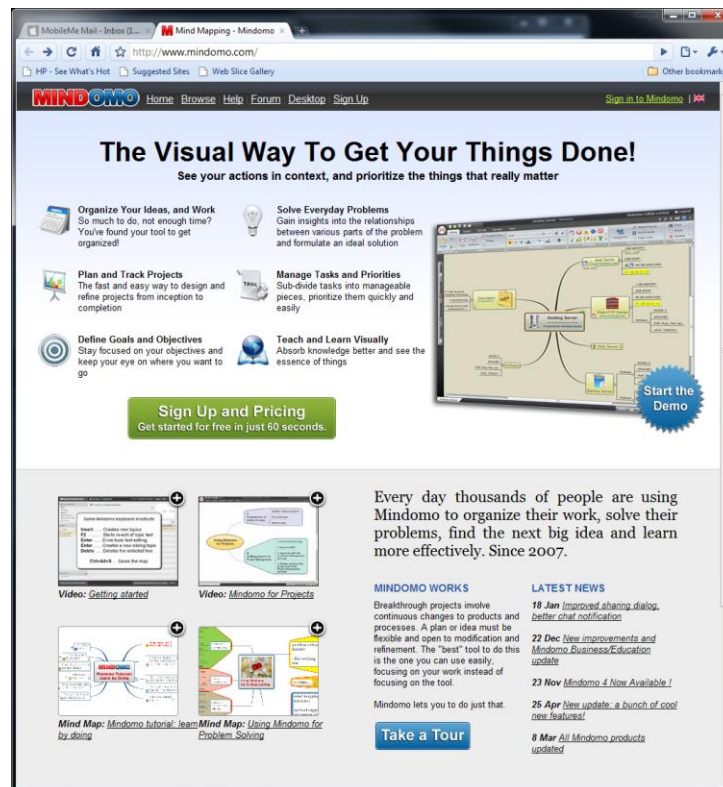
## Installing Mindomo:

1. There is no installation required, Mindomo uses Flash in the browser.
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
Using Mindomo: Below are a few points to get started.

First, go to [www.mindomo.com](http://www.mindomo.com)

On the homepage, you can sign up by clicking the green button in the middle of the page that says "Sign Up and Pricing".



You can choose from 3 options, Basic, Premium, and Team. Choose Basic to start, since it is free, by clicking the green "Sign Up" button under Basic.


You are then taken to a sign up page, asking you for your name, email address, creation of a username, and password. Click "I Agree" at the bottom when finished.

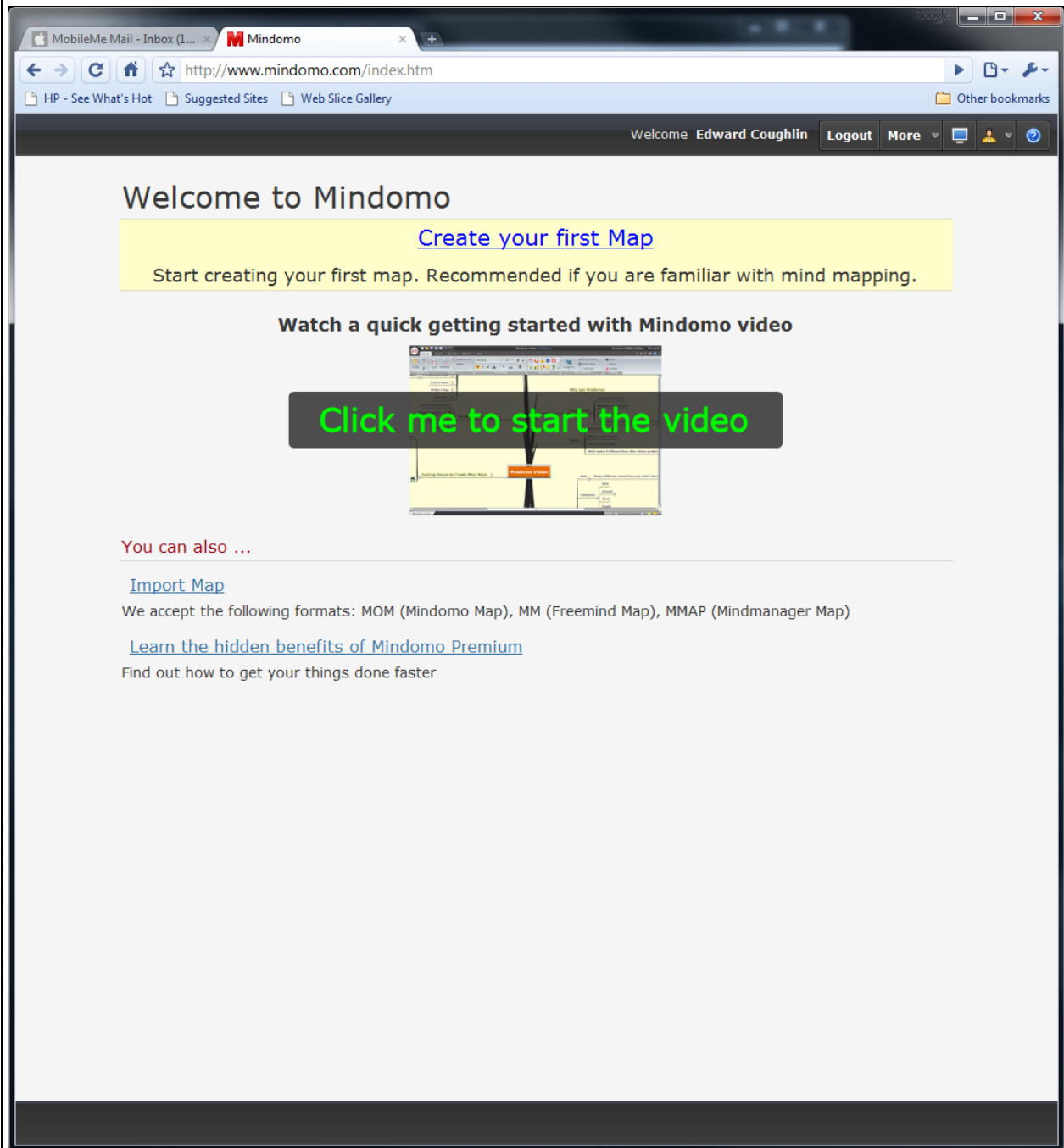

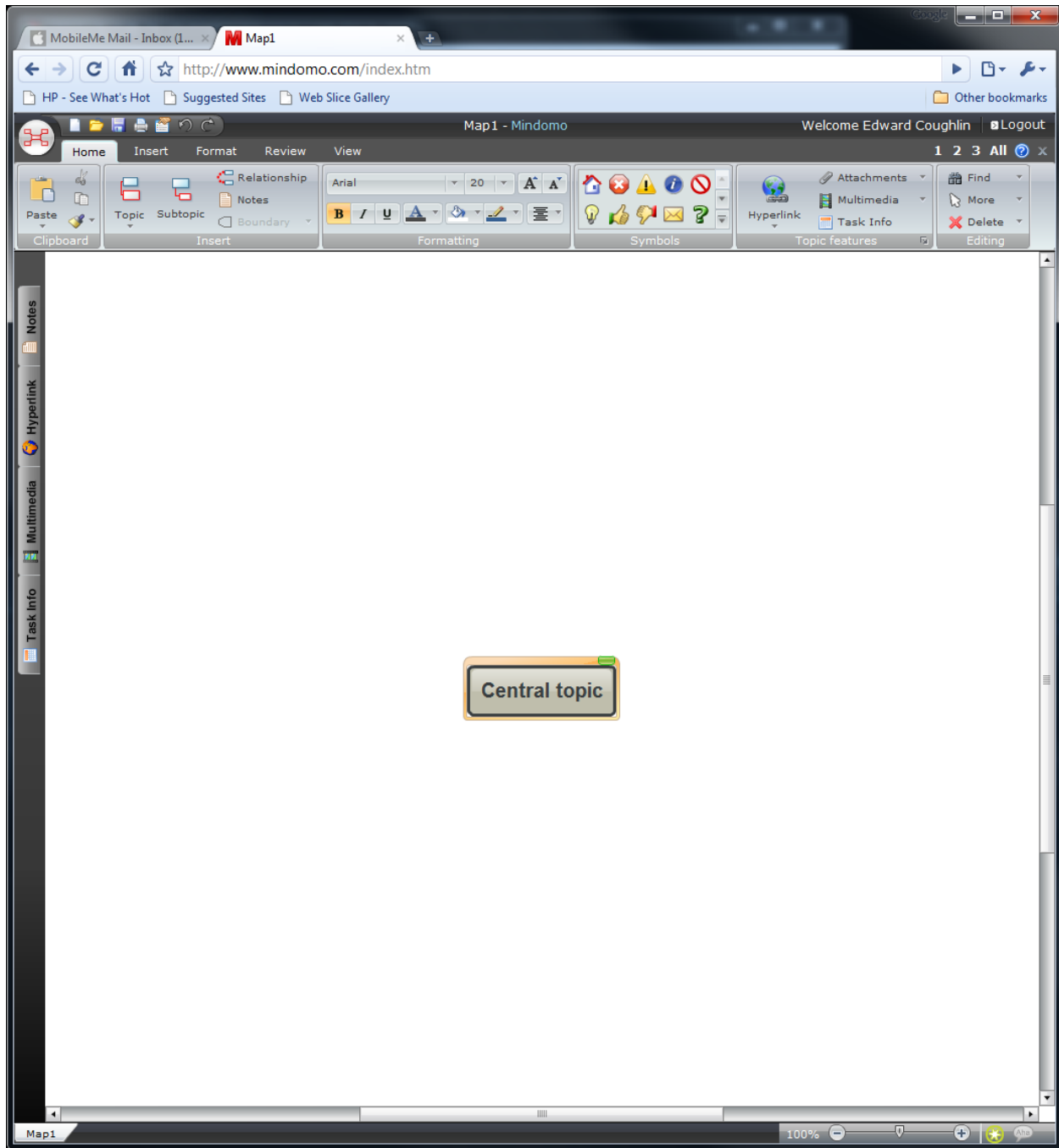

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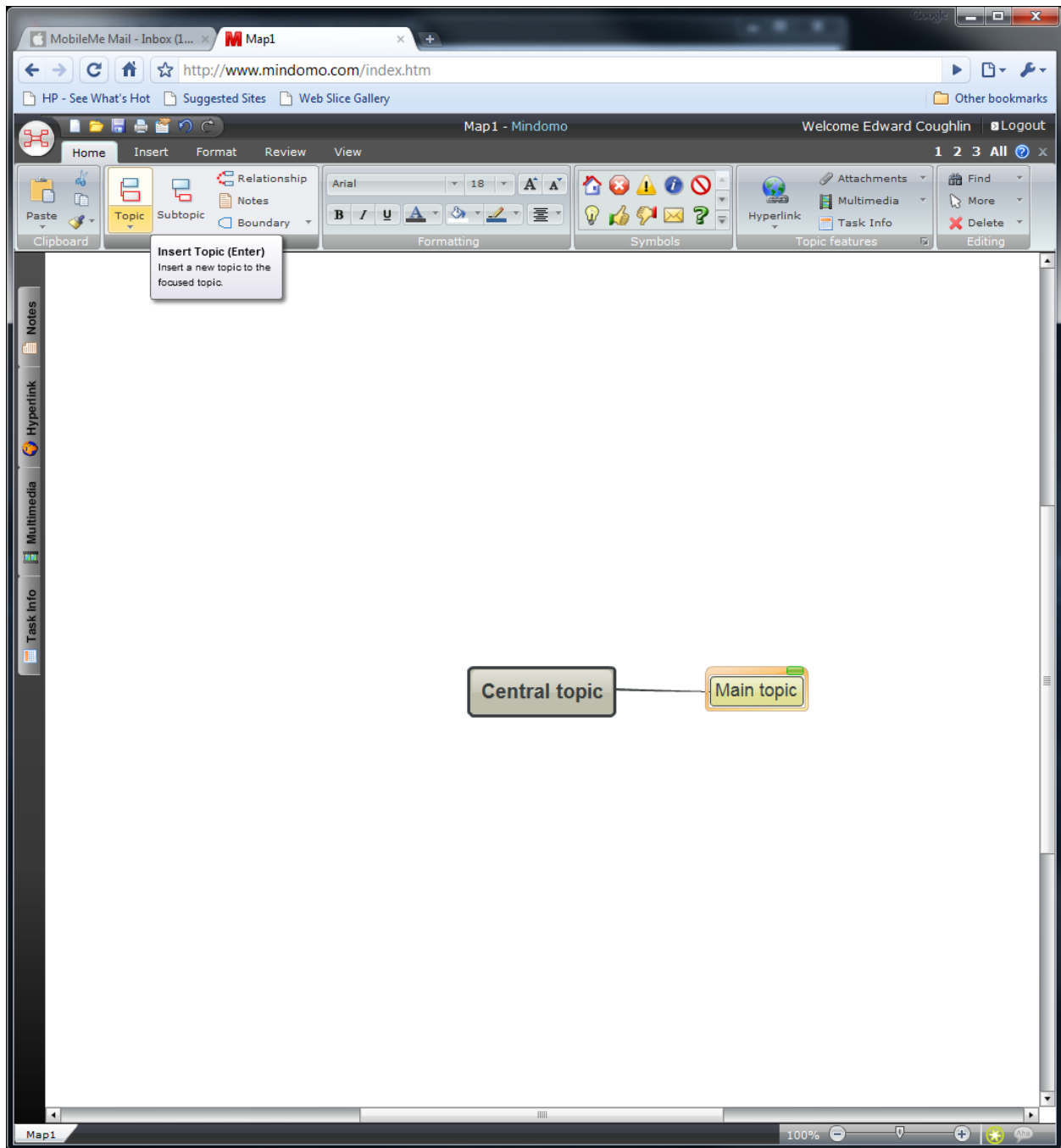
When signed in, your homepage will look a little bare, since you have no maps. Click the link in the middle of the page that says "Create your first Map".



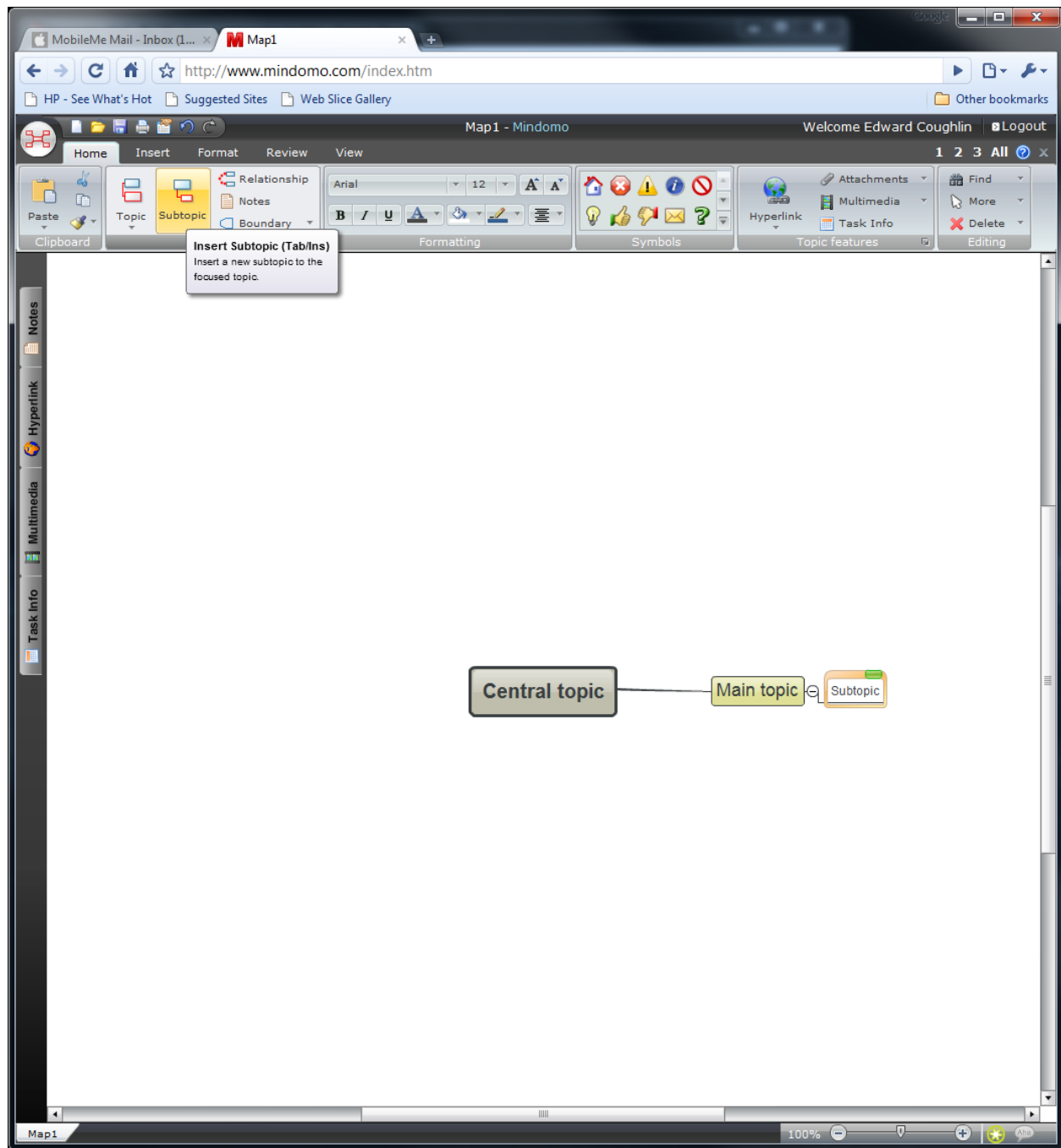
Your map will look like this to start. You are given a "Central Topic" in the middle of the page, with some customizing tools at the top.



Click "Topic" up in the upper left-hand corner of the options bar to add a new topic to your map.

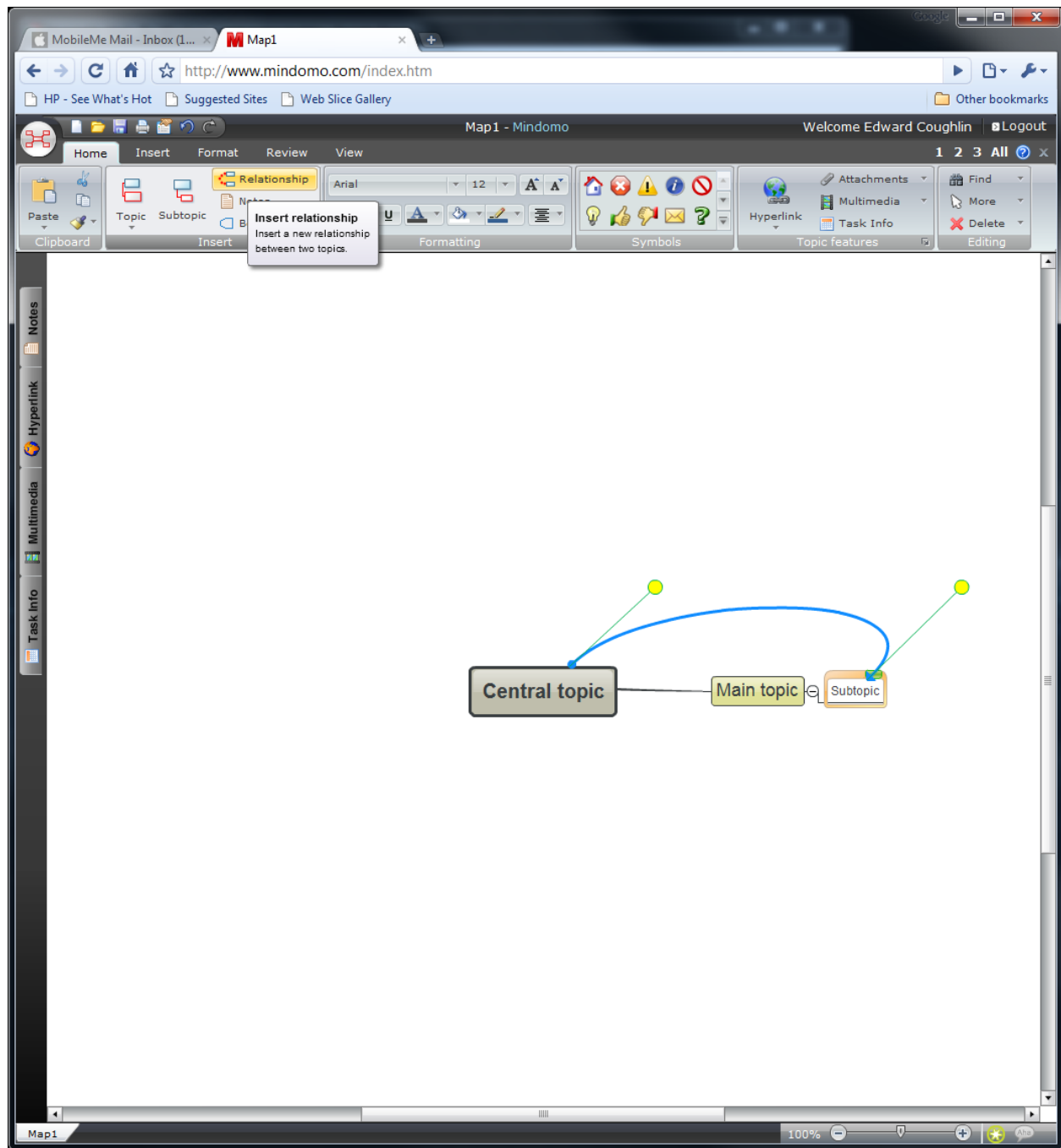


Click "Subtopic" in the upper left-hand corner of the options bar to create a subtopic of the topic you just added.

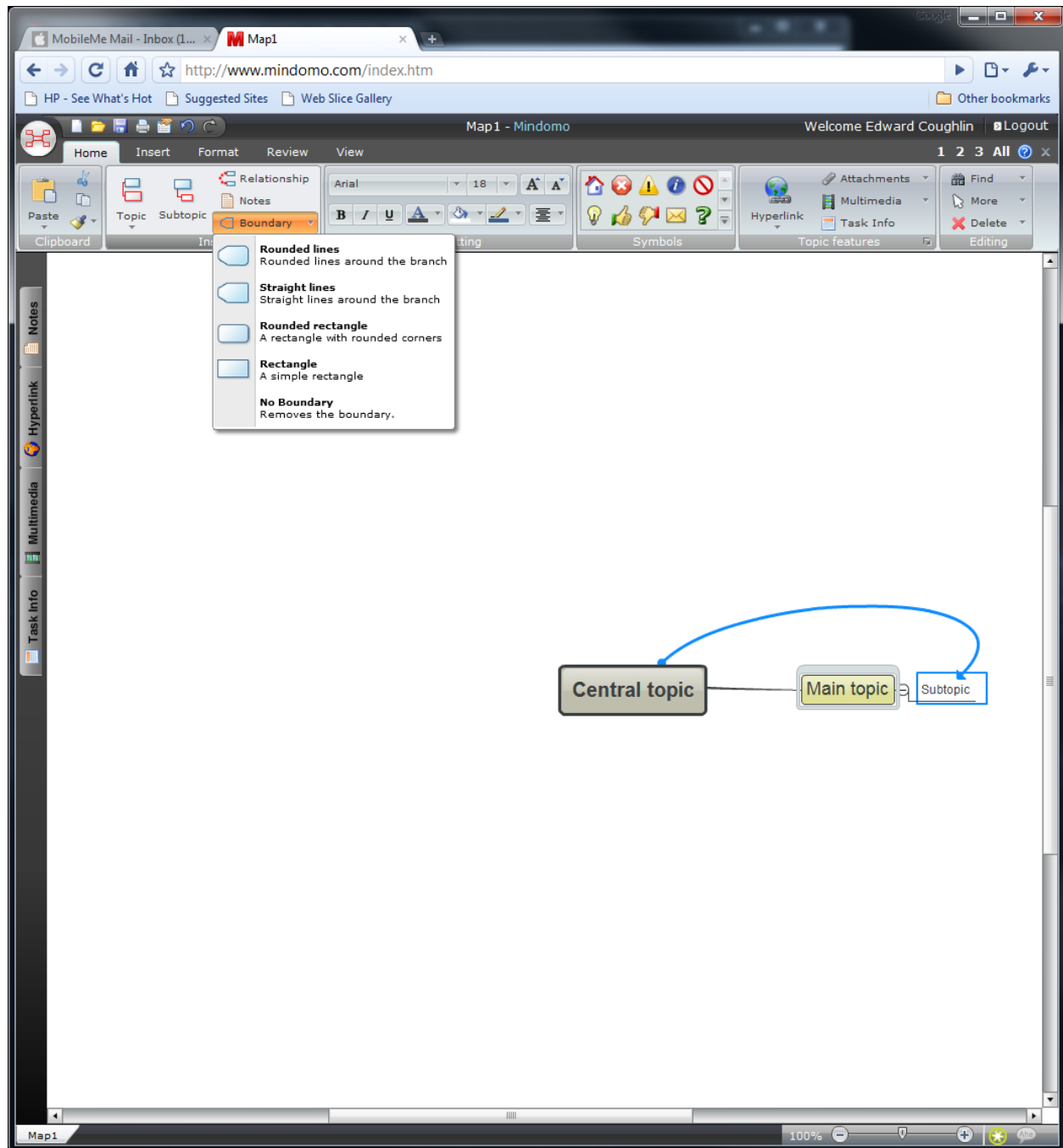




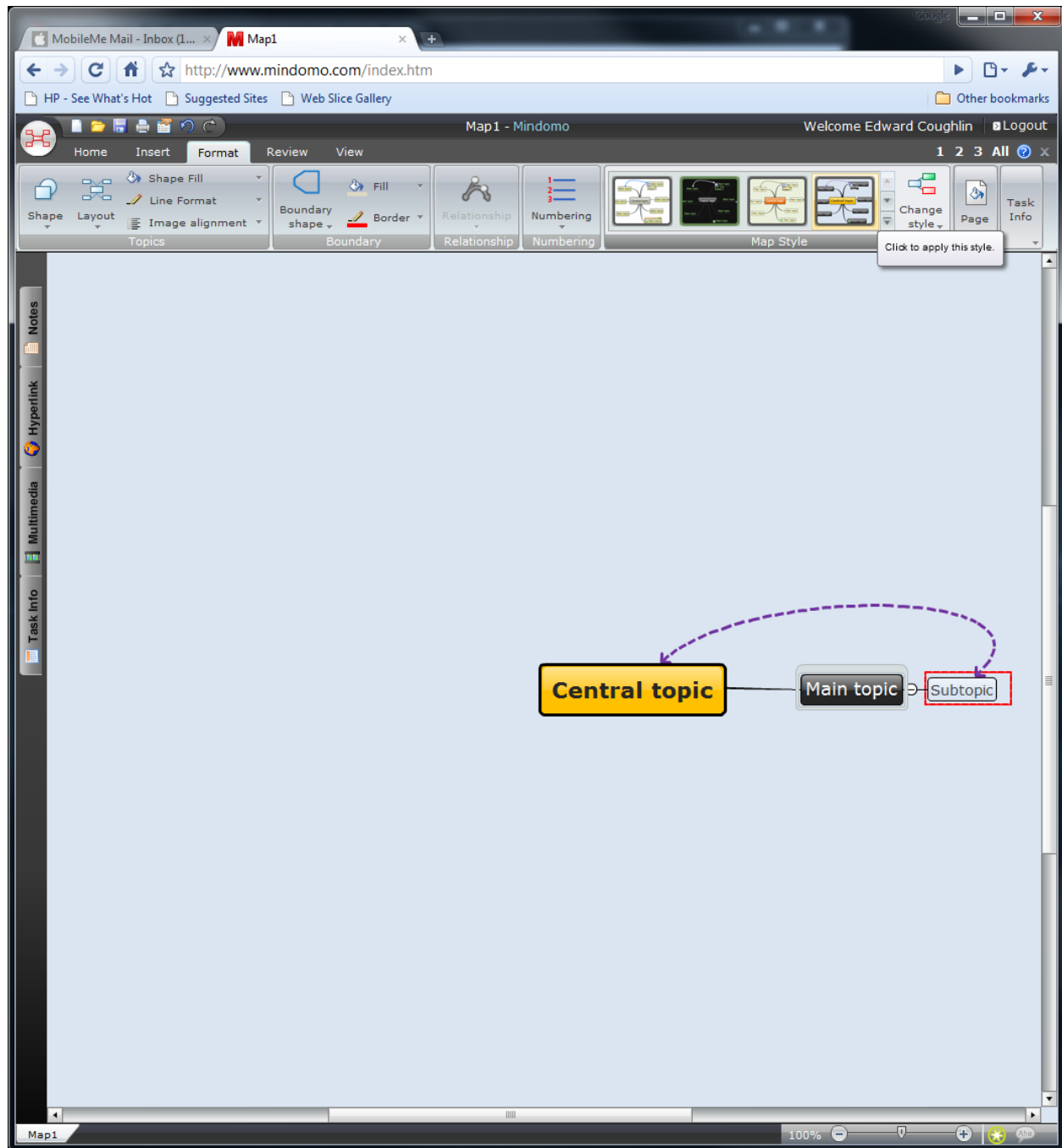
Click "Relationship" in the top options bar to define the relationships between your topics. Click on one topic and a line will be drawn out; click on the topic you wish to create the relationship with and it will be solidified.



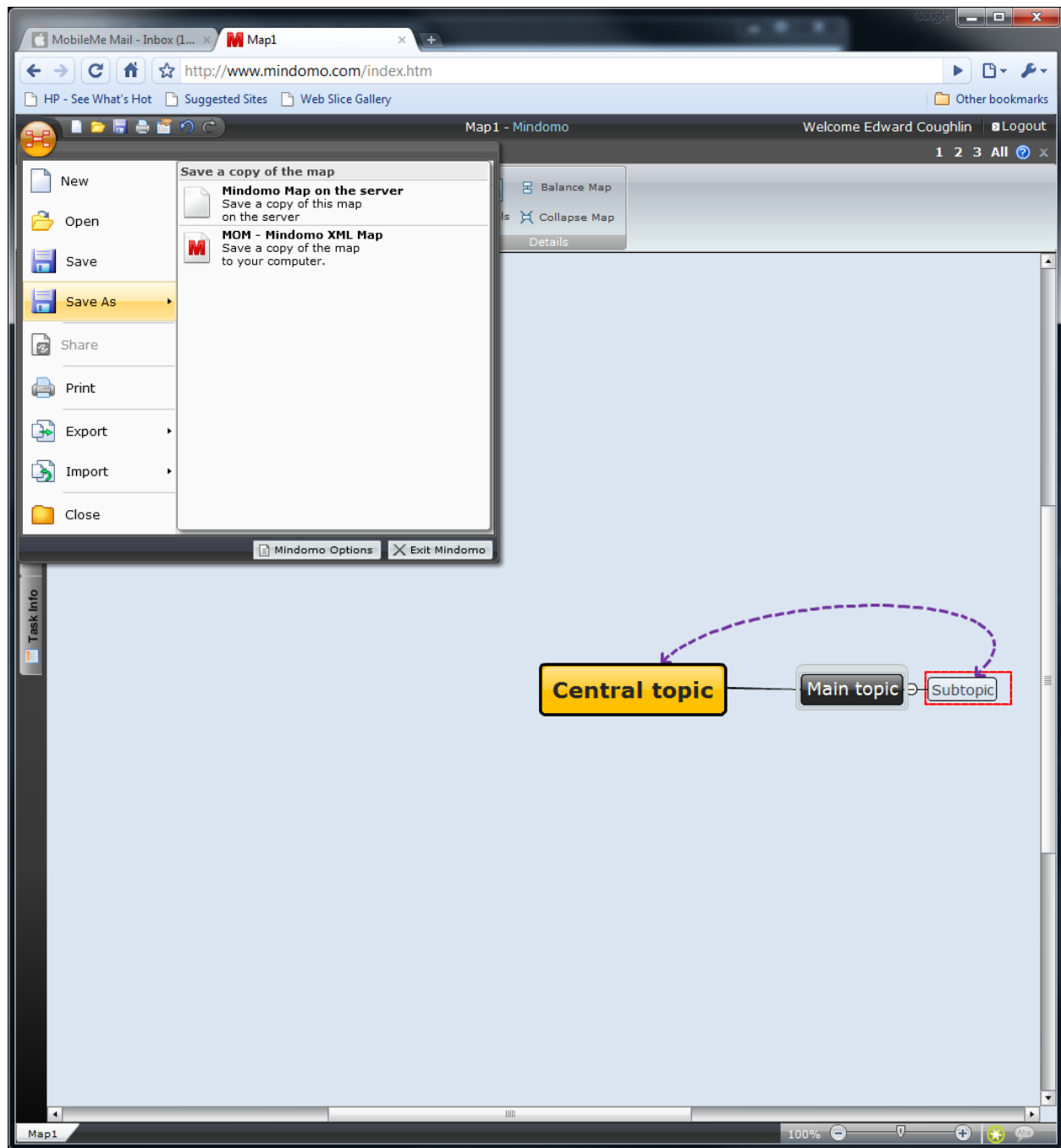
Just under "Relationship", is "Boundary". Click this in the options bar to customize the shape of the bounding box for your topics.



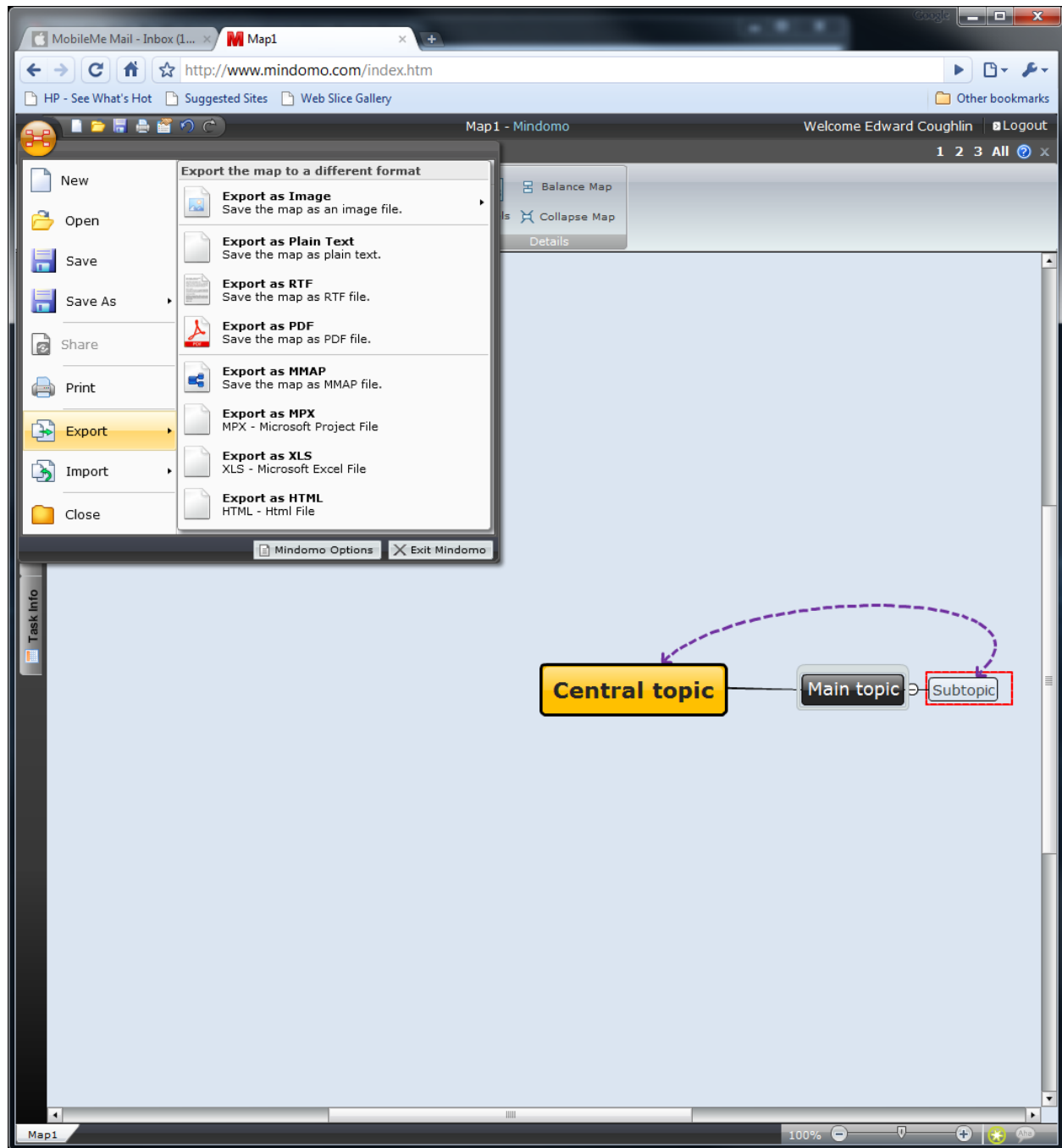
Choose a "Map Style" from the right-hand side of the options bar to change the look of your map.



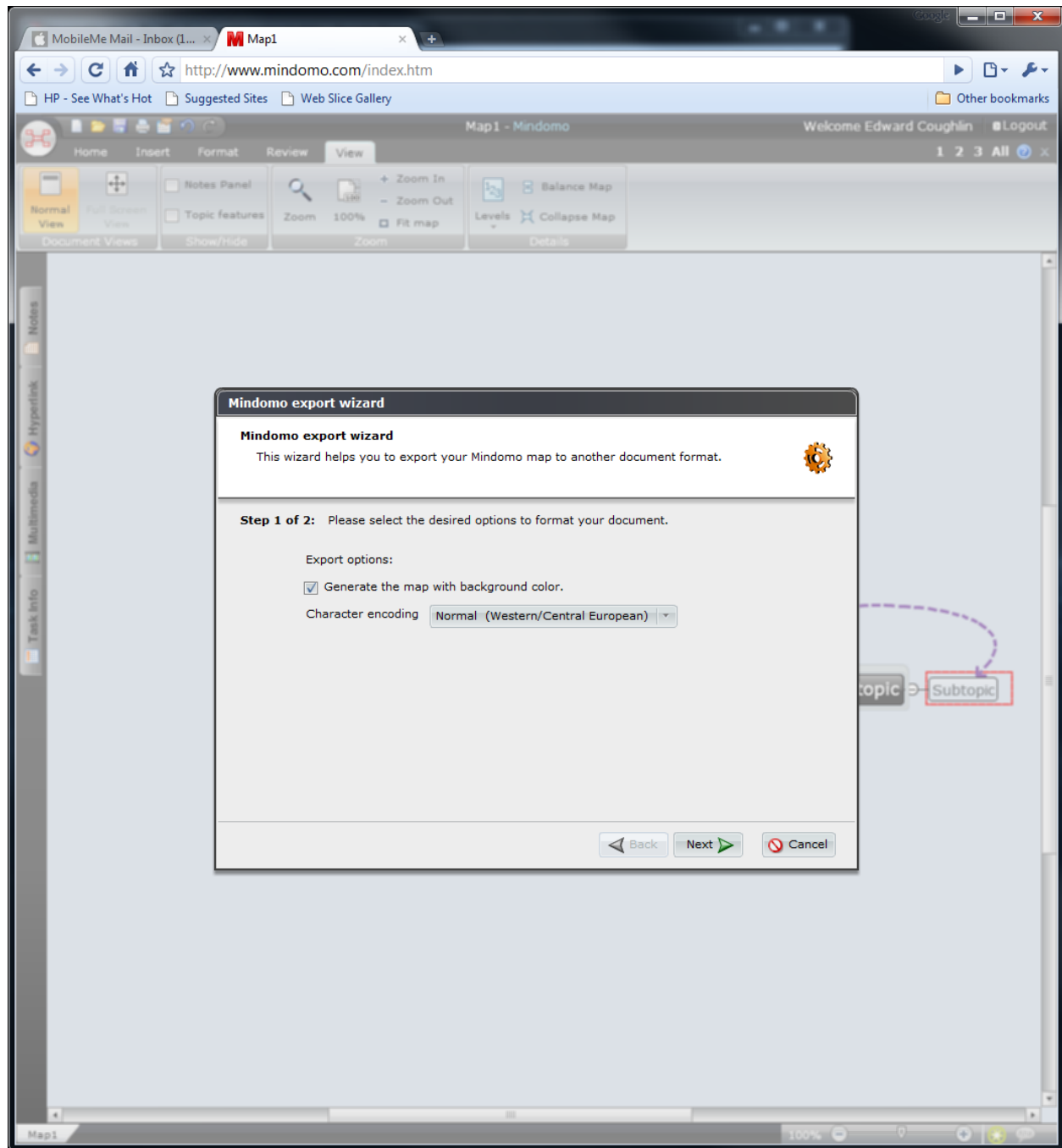
When you are finished with your map, click the circle in the upper left-hand corner of the options bar. A drop-down menu, similar to that of Word or Excel, will popup giving you options to save, open, save as, export, etc. Click "Save As" to save your map.



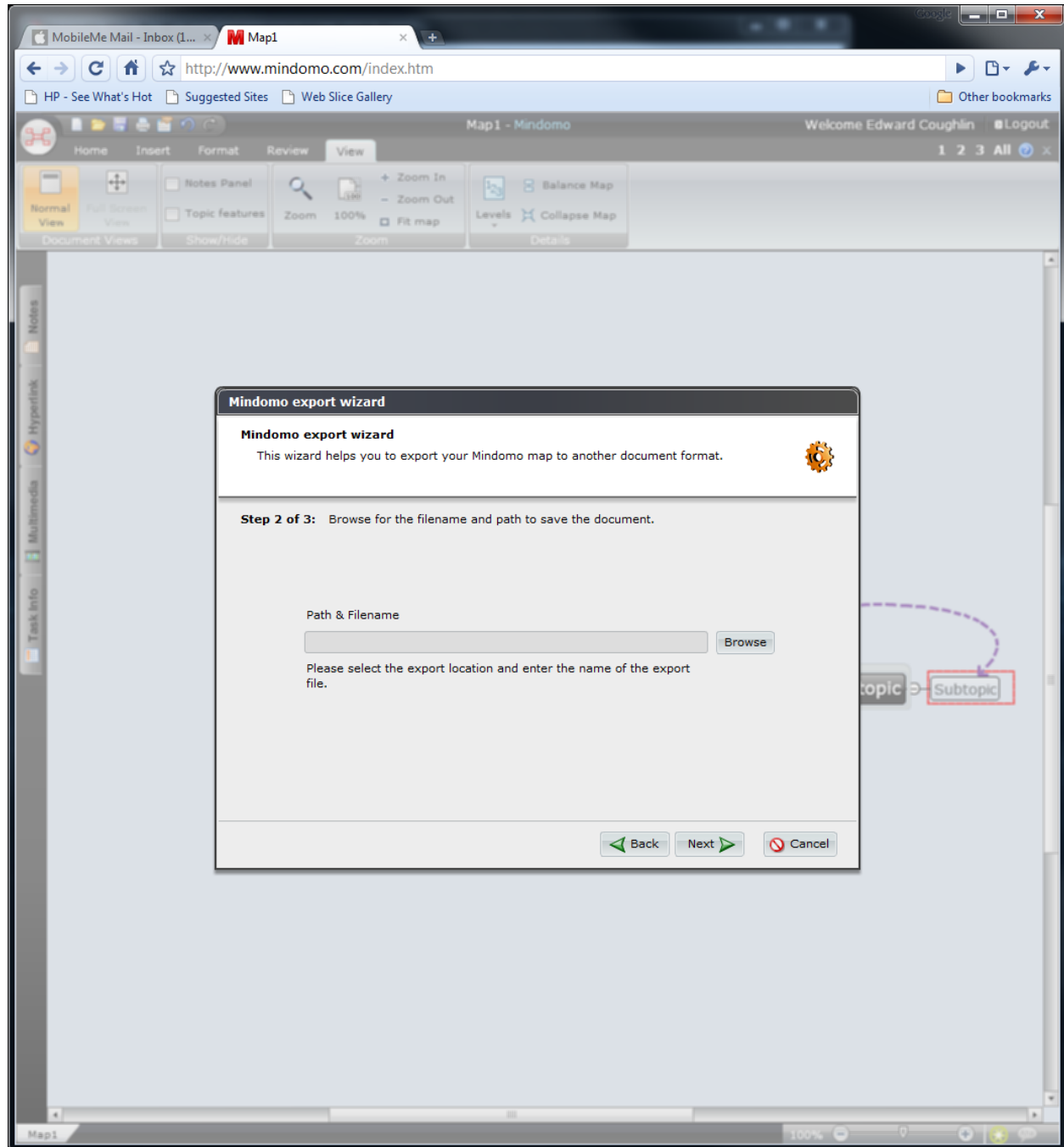
Click "Export" to define your map as a different file format.



After clicking "Export", you are given a popup box, asking for country encoding options. Click "Next".



You are then asked to "Browse" where you would like to export your new map to. Click "Browse" to choose a file path, then click "Next".



You are given a confirmation saying your map has finished exporting. Click "Finish" and your all done!
