Signup Requirements: Signup is required for SlideRocket. User must have a valid email address.

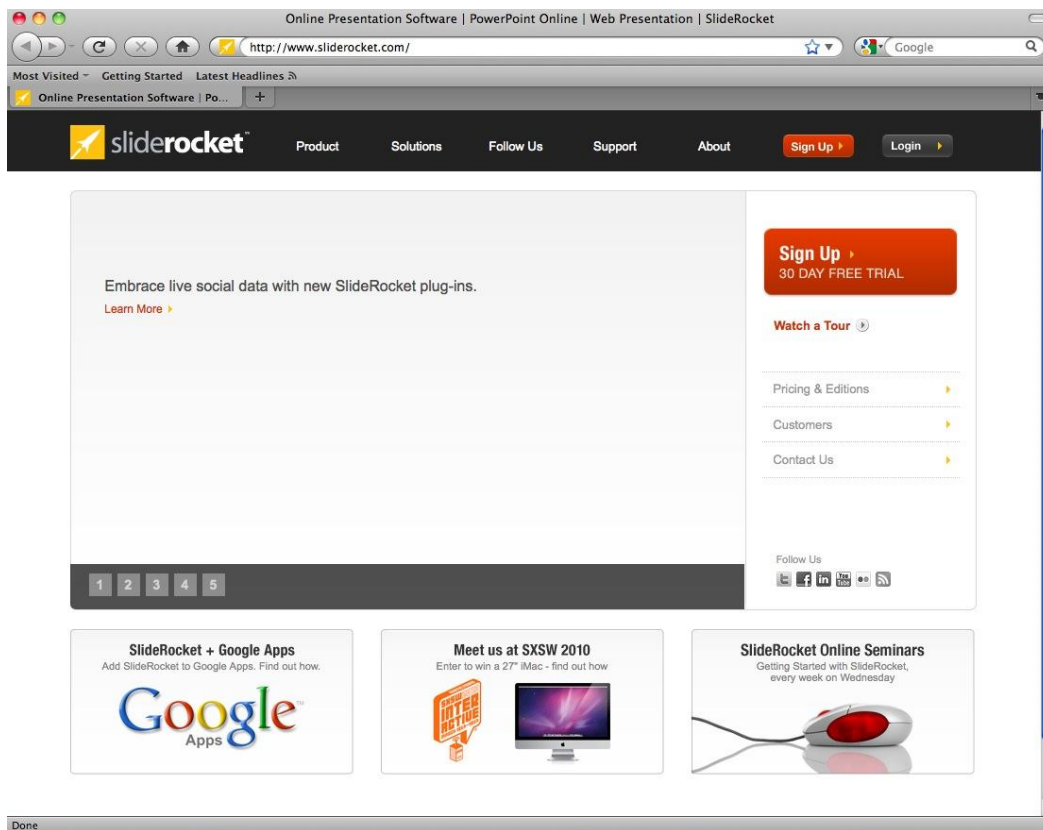
Installing Sliderocket:


Using SlideRocket: The following guide will help you get up and running with Sliderocket in no time!

Go to the website www.sliderocket.com to get started.

At the homepage, click the big, red "Sign Up" button, on the right.



You are then taken to the Registration page, where you will need to provide an email address, create a password, your name and job title, and the industry you work in. When finished, click "Submit" at the bottom.

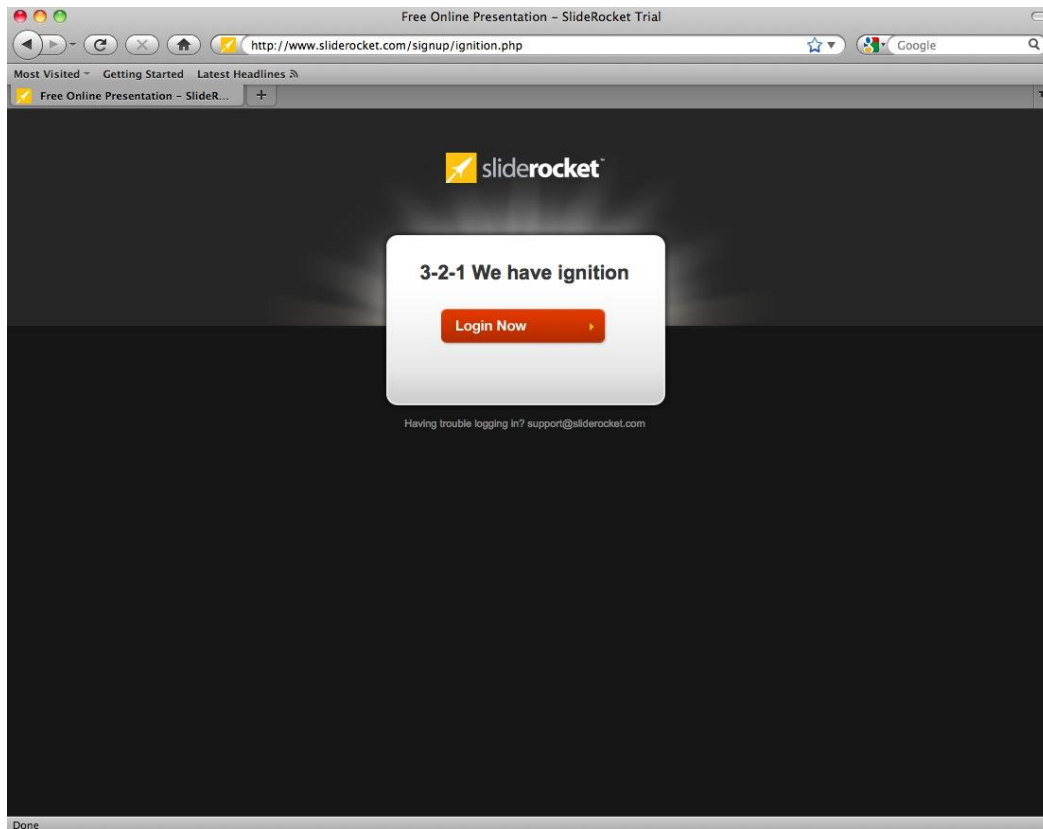

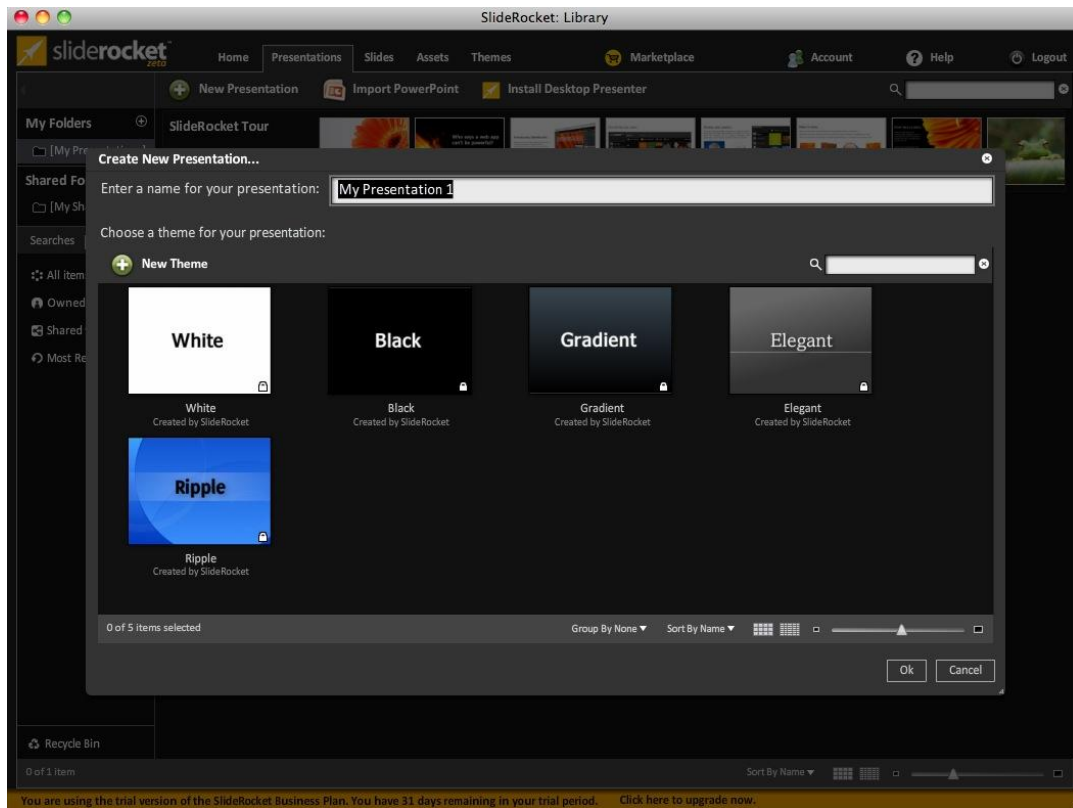
SlideRocket will then automatically log you in. Click "Login Now" to launch the presentation window.



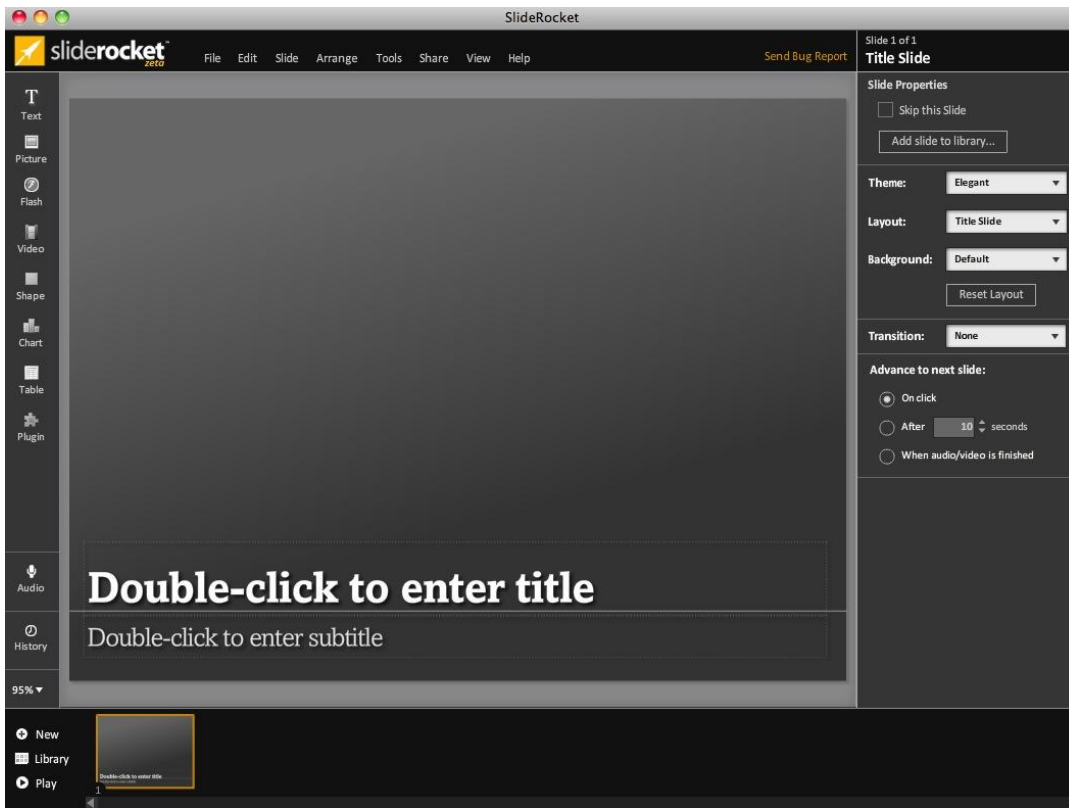
Here is the presentation application window. First, you will be presented with the welcome screen, asking if you would like to watch a tutorial, import a PowerPoint presentation, or create your own new presentation. Click "Create a new presentation".



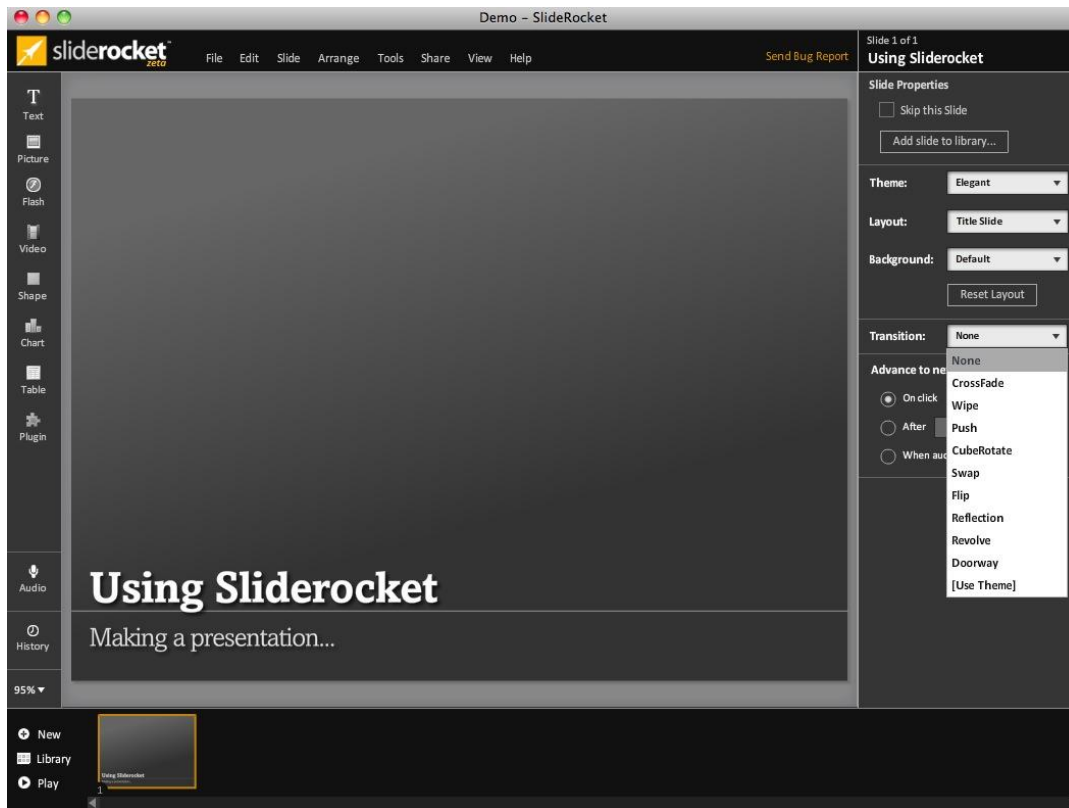
Give a title to your new presentation, then choose a theme. Click “OK” in the bottom right-hand corner to continue.



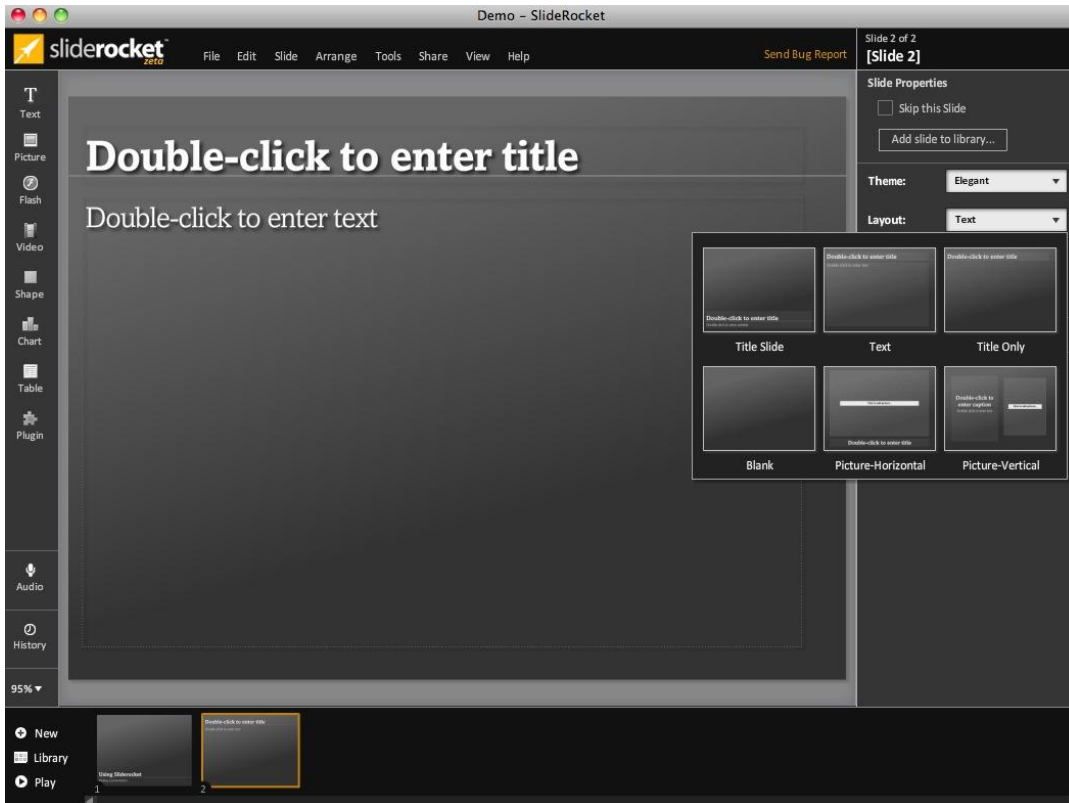
The first slide you will be given is the Title Slide. Click on each piece of text to edit it.



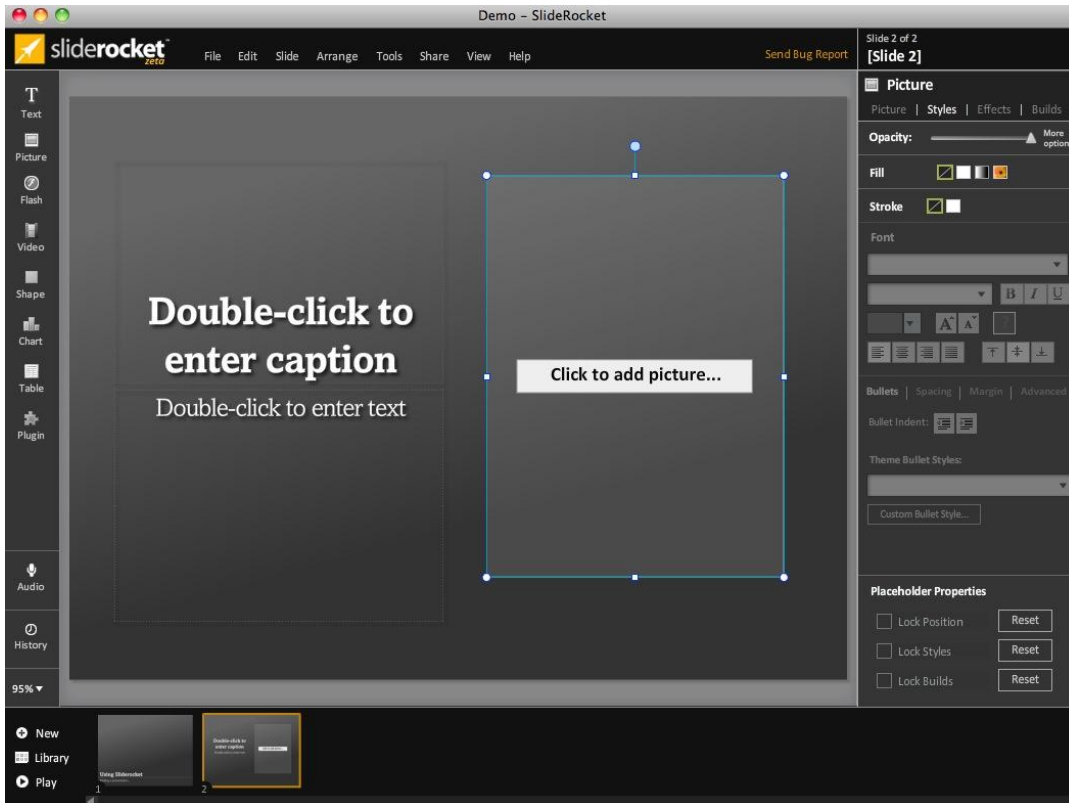
Choose a transition effect for your slide by clicking the Transition drop-down menu on the right. Upon choosing one, SlideRocket will demo the transition for you.



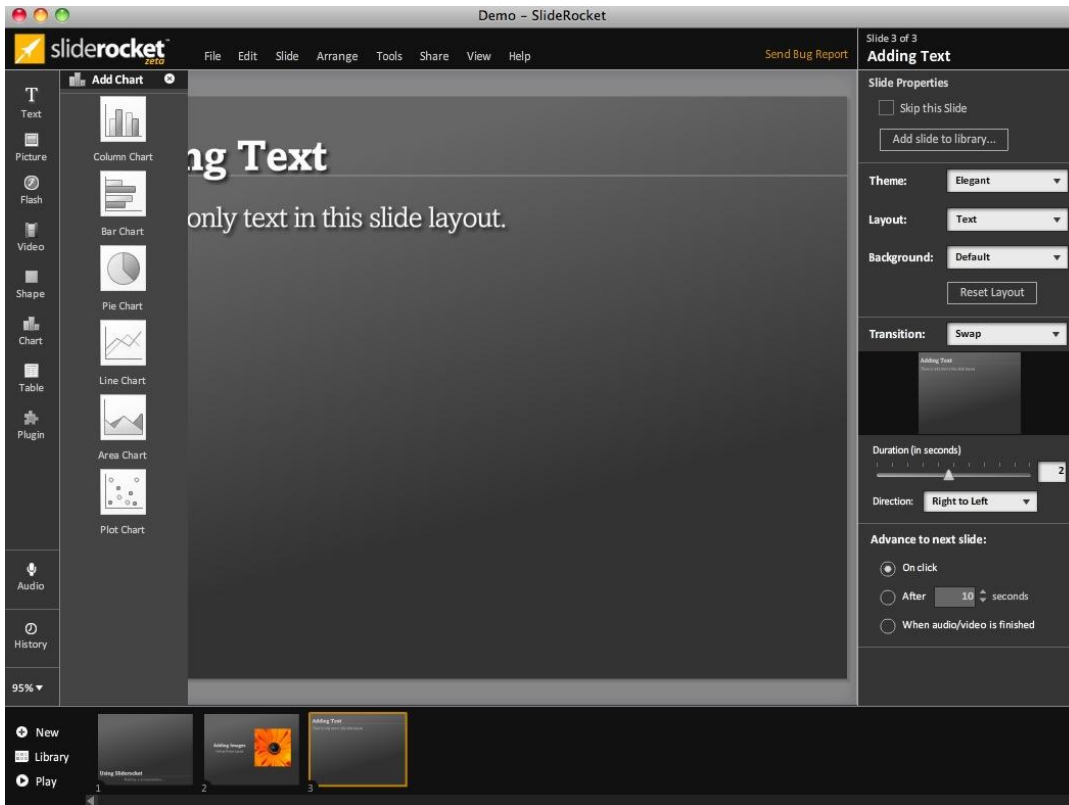
To make a new slide, click “New” in the bottom left-hand corner. To change the layout type of the slide, click the Layout drop-down menu on the right-hand side.



Similar to editing text, click on the image placeholder to edit the picture. A screen up popup asking you for an image.



You can add charts, graphs, and images to any slide, regardless of layout type. To add a chart, click “Chart” on the left-hand side. A popup menu will prompt you to choose a type of chart.



Again, you can edit any part by double-clicking it.

When you are finished with your presentation, go to "File" in the top left-hand corner, and click "Save".



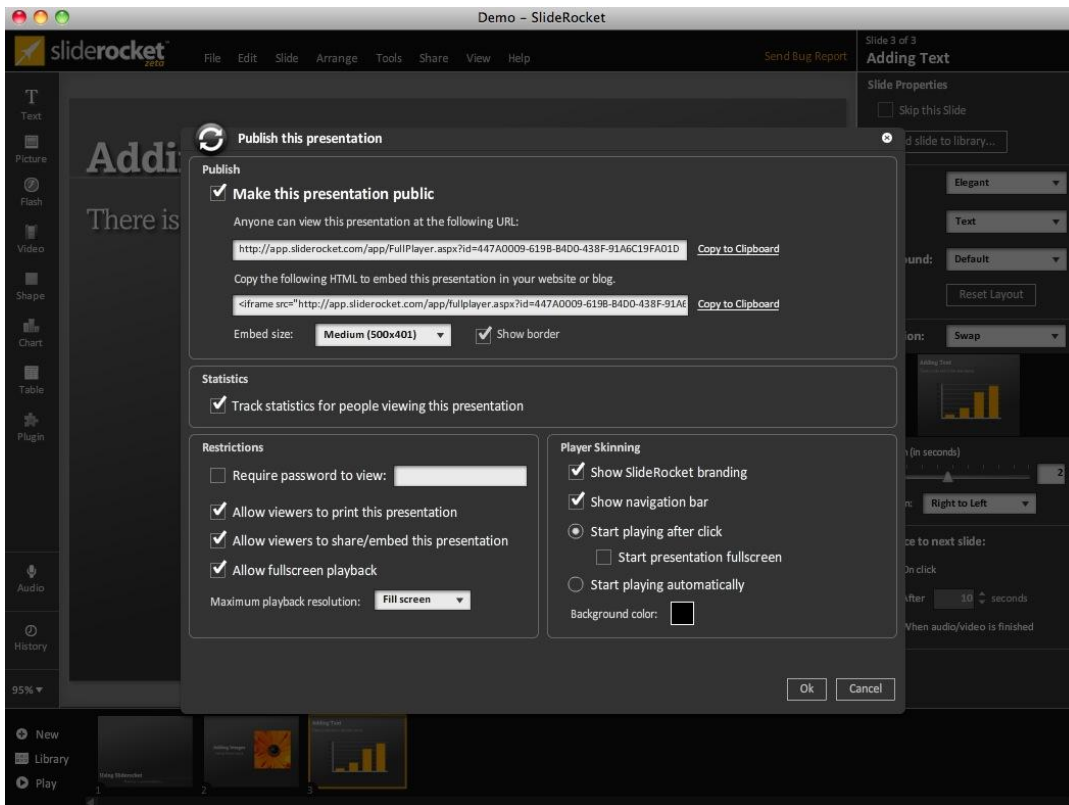
To publish your new presentation, go to “Share” in the top middle, and click “Publish”.

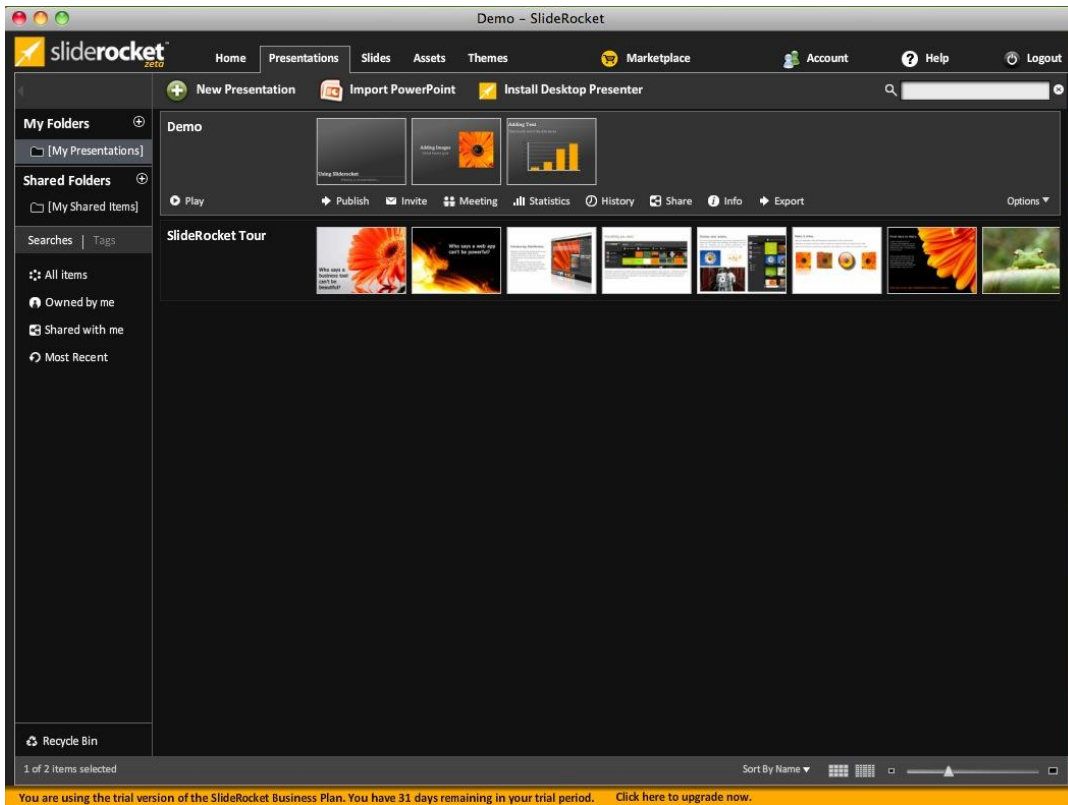

To exit the editing screen, go to "File" and click "Close". You are then taken to your mainpage, showing all your presentations. You can also choose to Publish, Share, and Export from here as well.



When Exporting, a popup will ask for the file type you would like to export out into. After that, you are all done! You have made your first presentation in SlideRocket!
