
Using Weebly: Below are a few points to get started.

First, go to www.weebly.com

Signup for a free account on the homepage by creating a username, password, and entering in a valid email address. Then click "Sign Up".



You are then prompted for a site title. Enter a title and click "Continue".

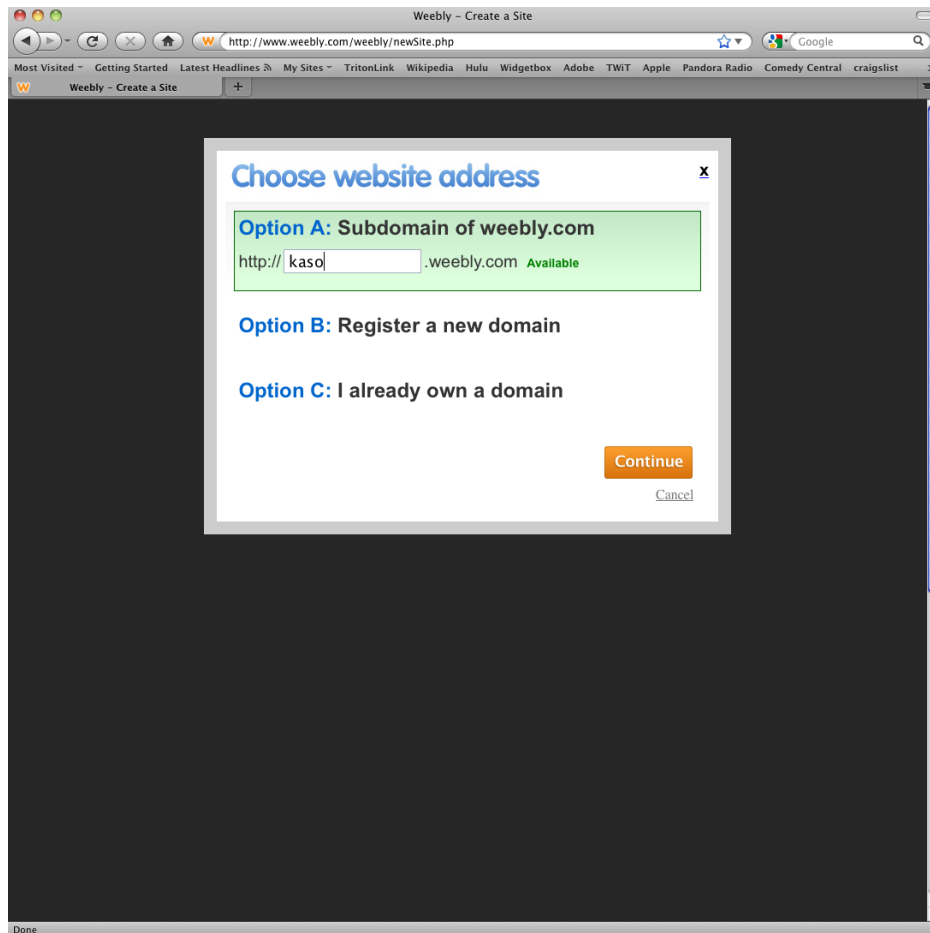

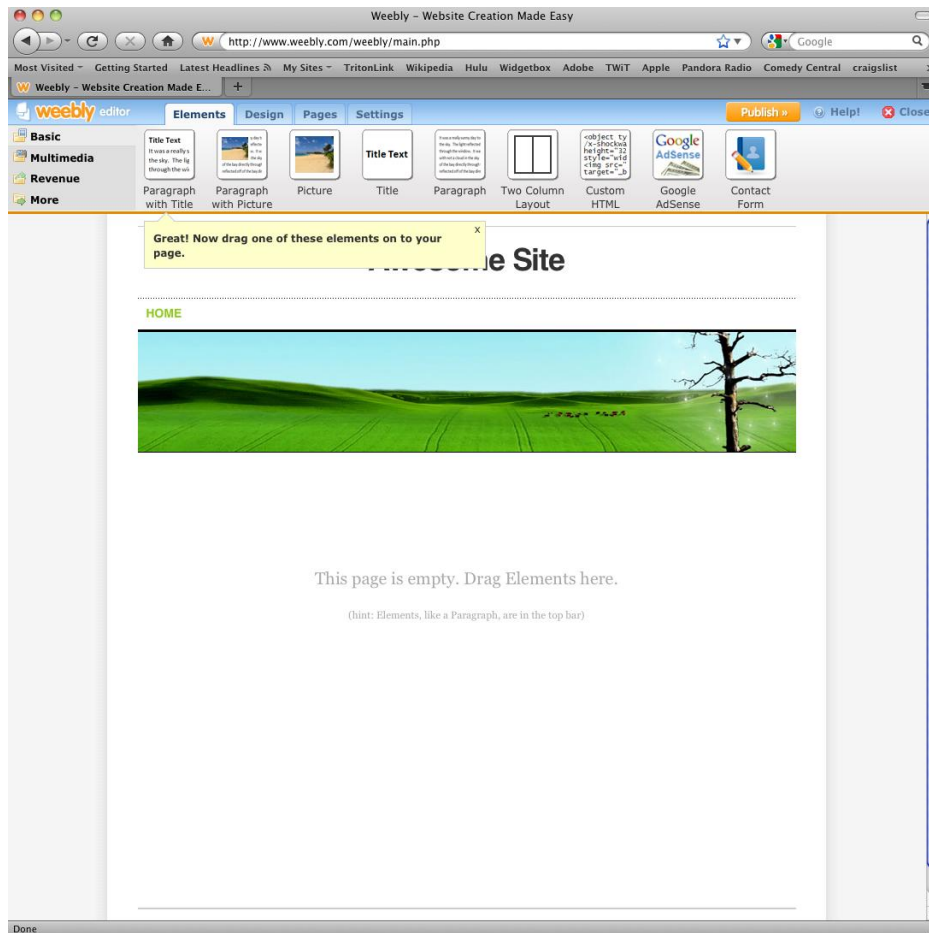

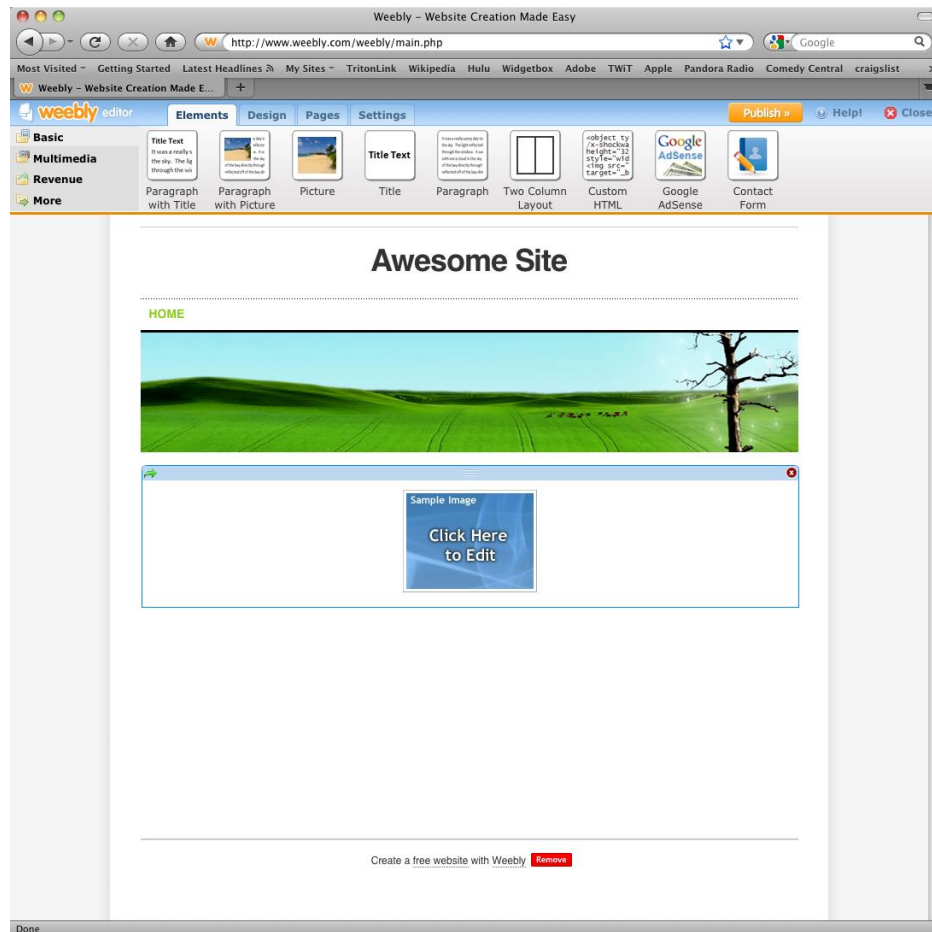
Then, Weebly will ask for a website address. Here you have 3 options. First, you can use a subdomain of weebly.com, consisting of your username, this option is free. Second, you can register a new domain name, which costs an annual fee. Third, you can enter in a domain name if you already have one.



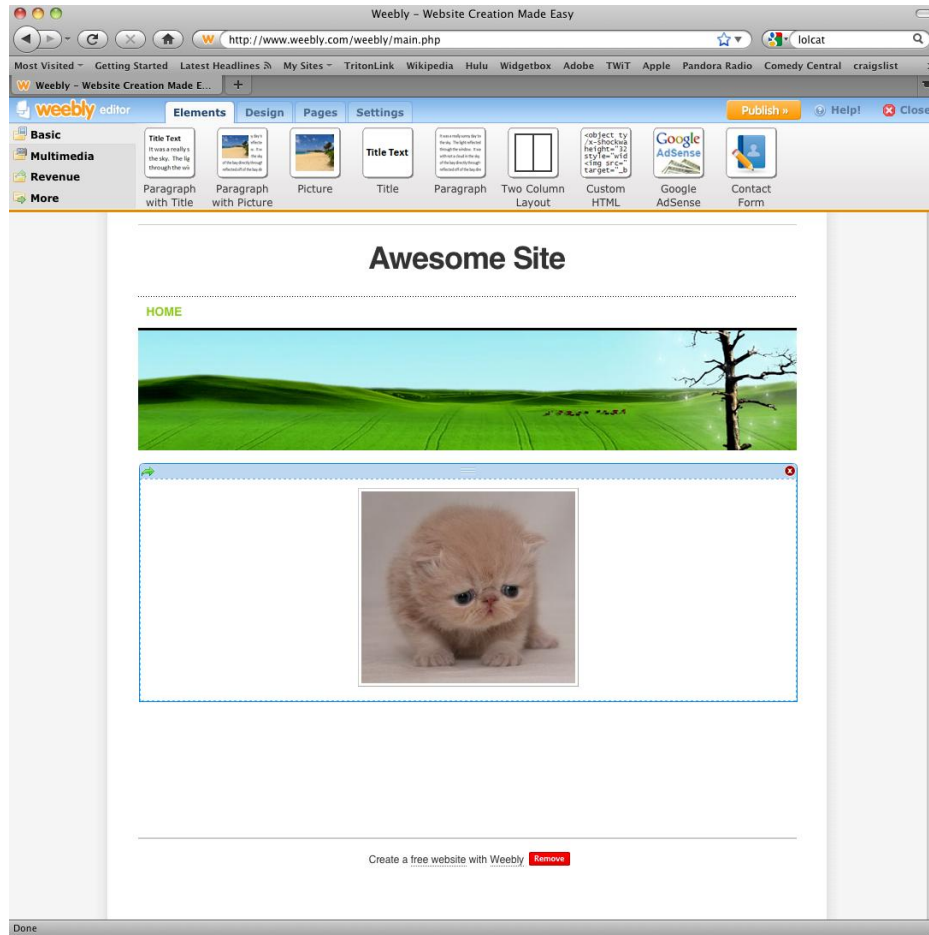
Now you are ready to start customizing your site. The top bar shows all the design and content options you have to choose from, and below is your site. Simply drag an element from the top bar, down to the site below, and drop it where you would like it on the page.



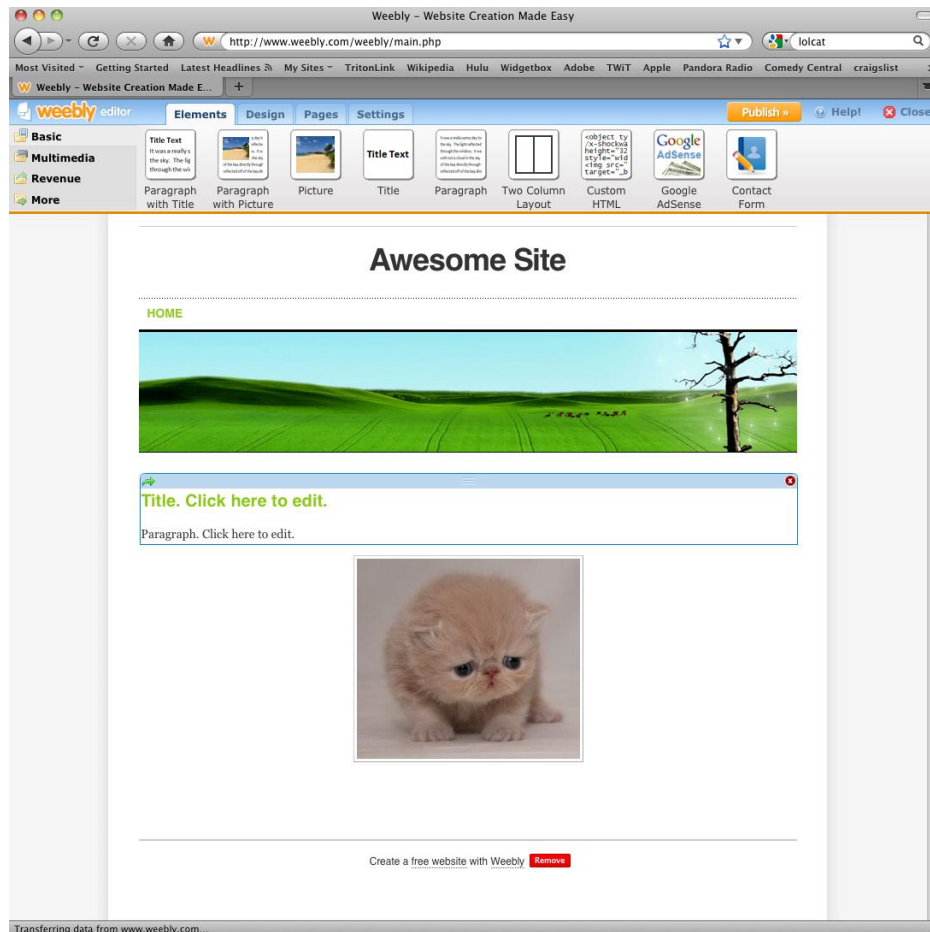
When adding images, it first adds a placeholder image to your page. Once clicked upon, the placeholder image will prompt you to upload an image from your hard drive.



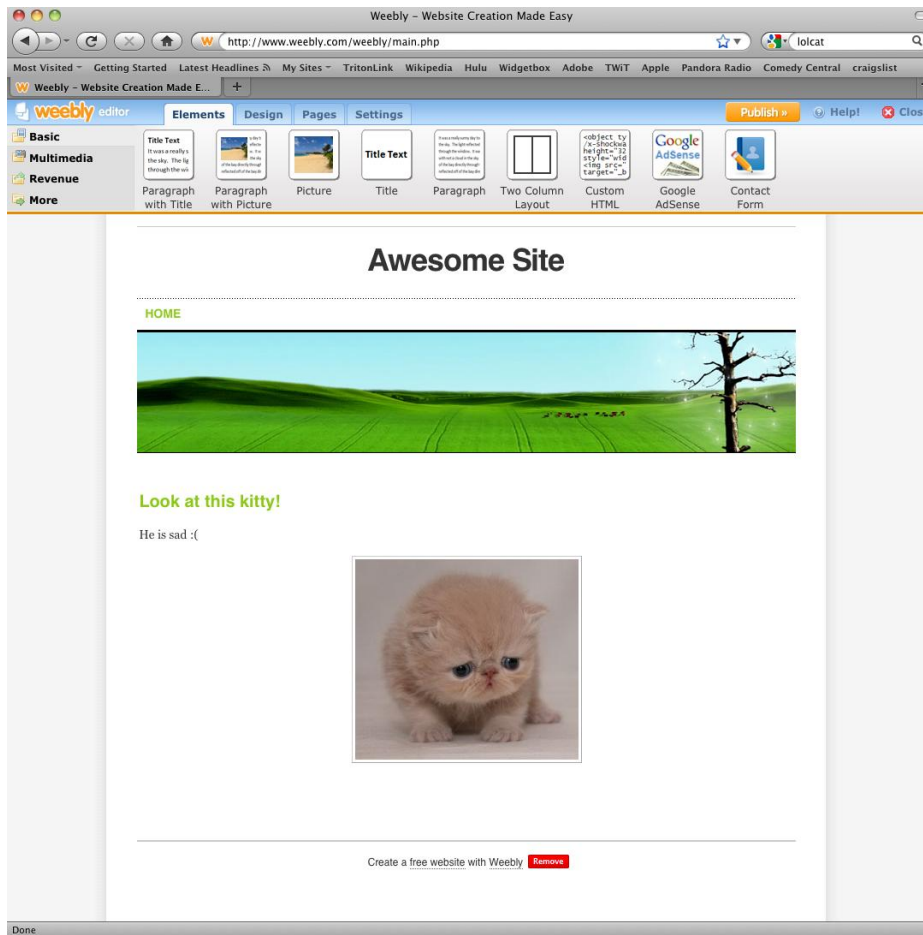
You can then resize that image as you see fit.



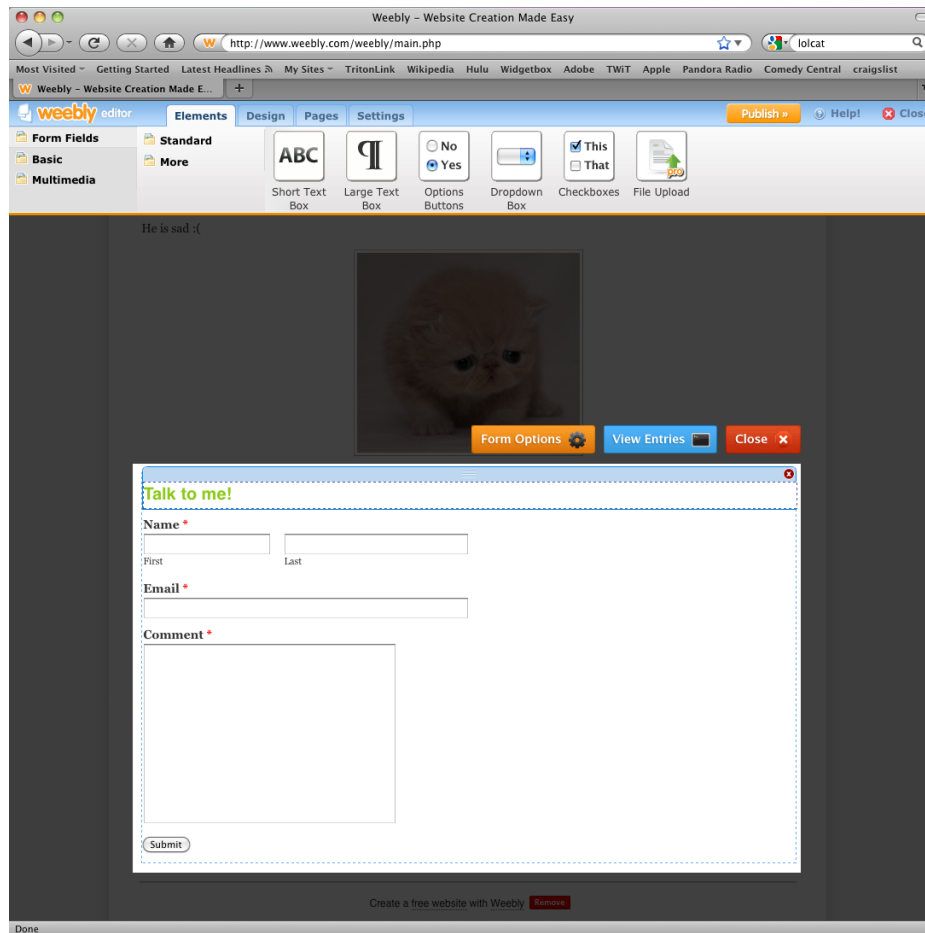
When adding text content, similarly to the image content, placeholder text is first added; prompting you to click on it and edit. You are given title text along with some standard content text.



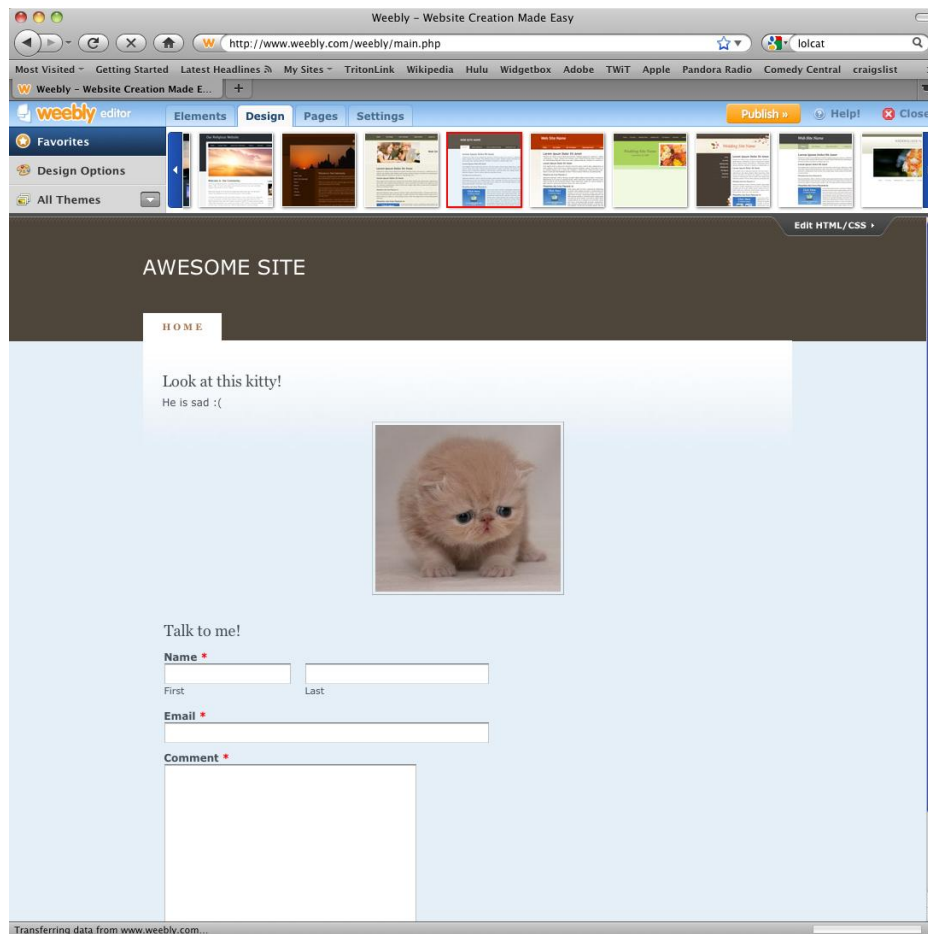
The font, size, and color of the text is all customizable.



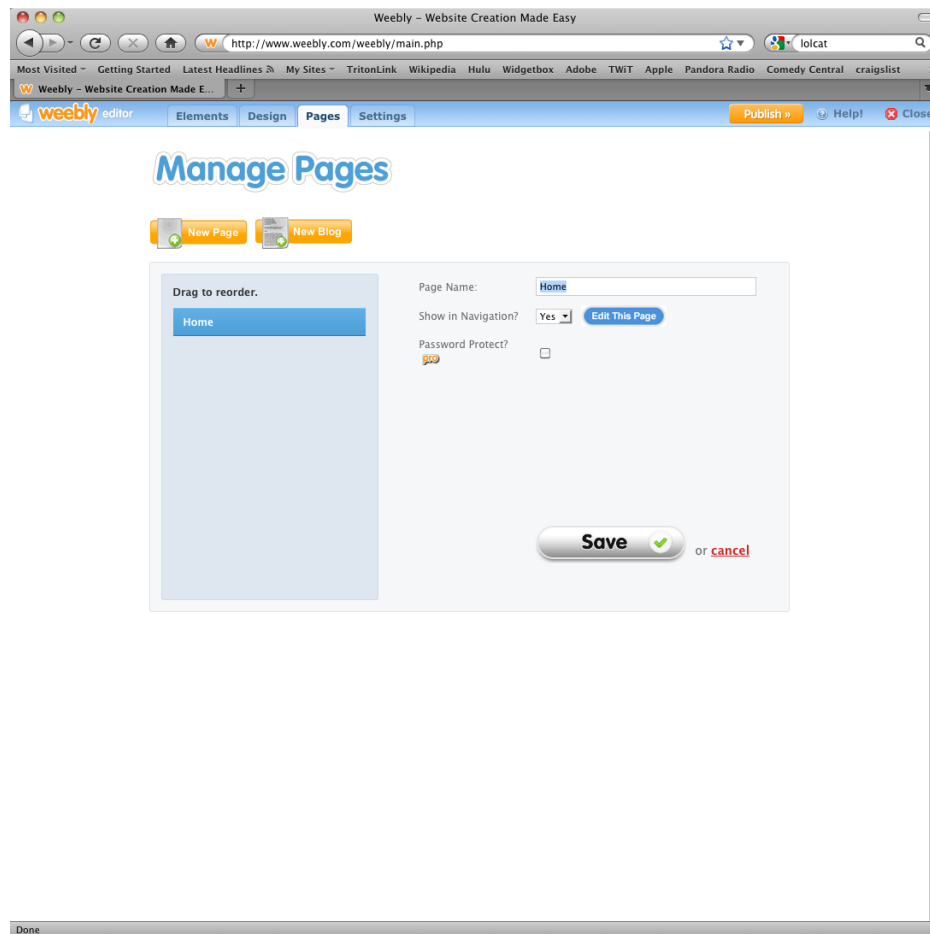
When adding contact forms, each element of the form is customizable.



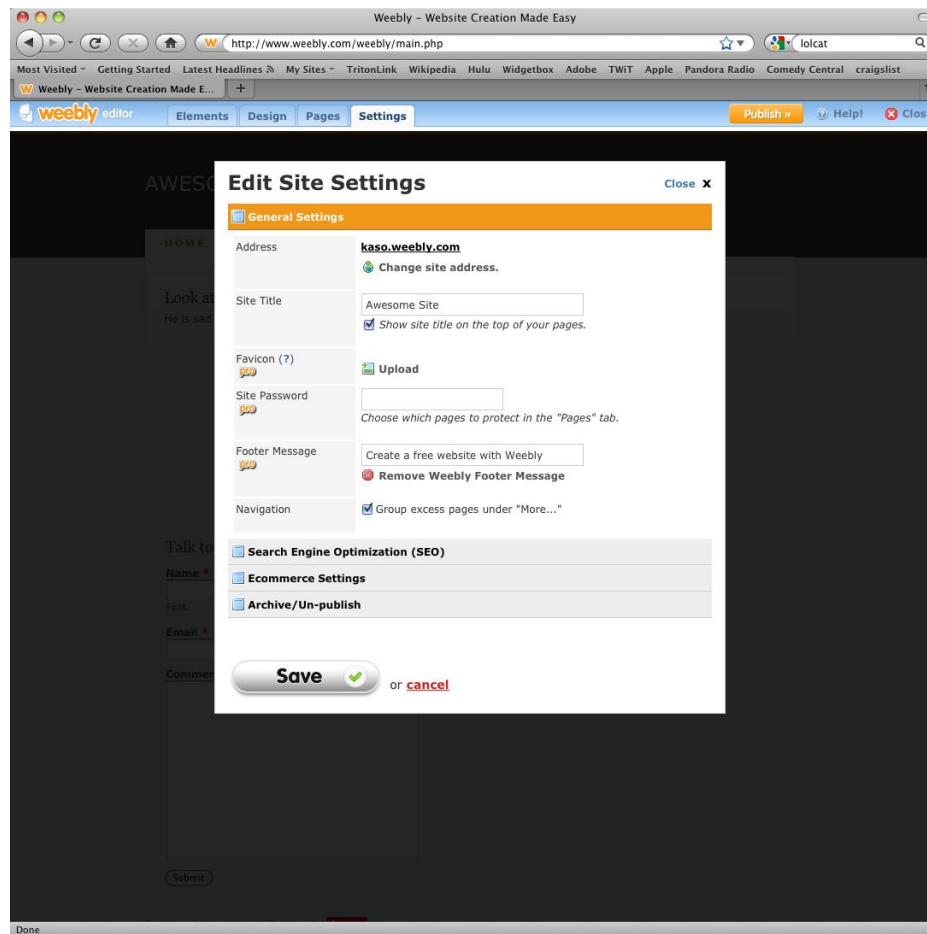
Clicking the "Design" tab at the top, gives you an array of design templates with which to work in. Rolling over each will give you a quick preview of how it will look, then you can click the thumbnail to keep that design.



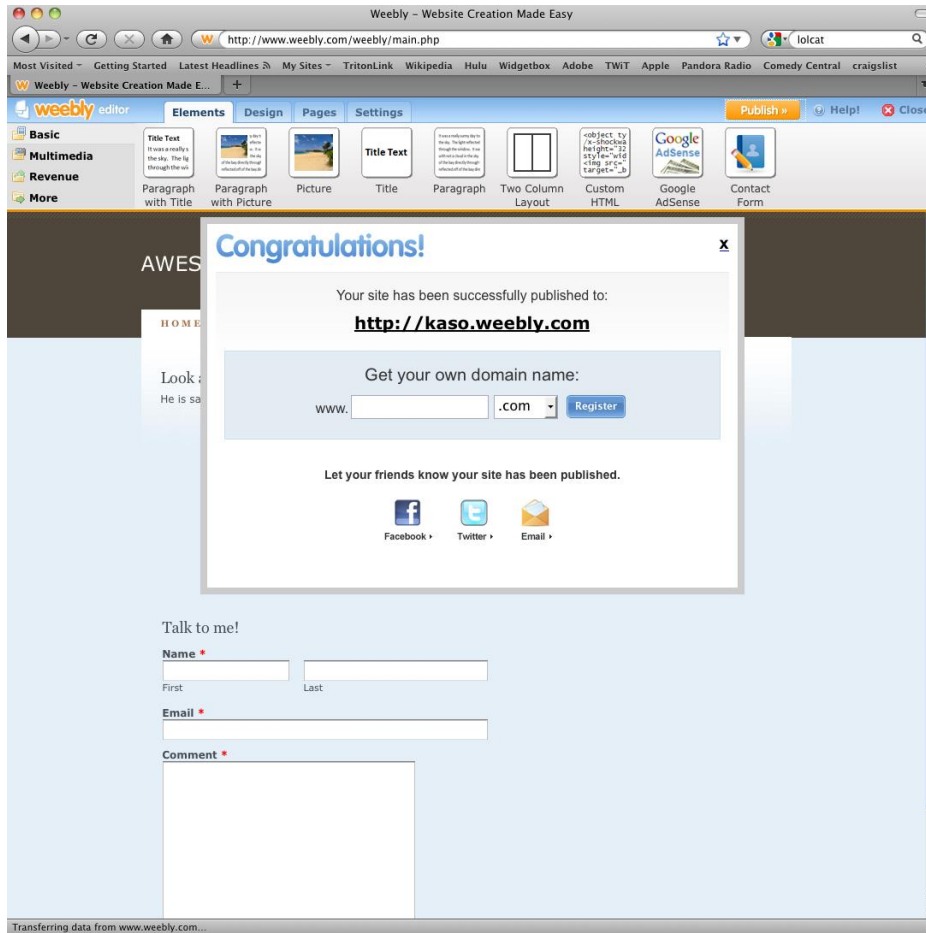
Clicking the "Pages" tab at the top gives you the ability to manage the pages in your site. From here, you can add more pages, as well as adding blog pages.



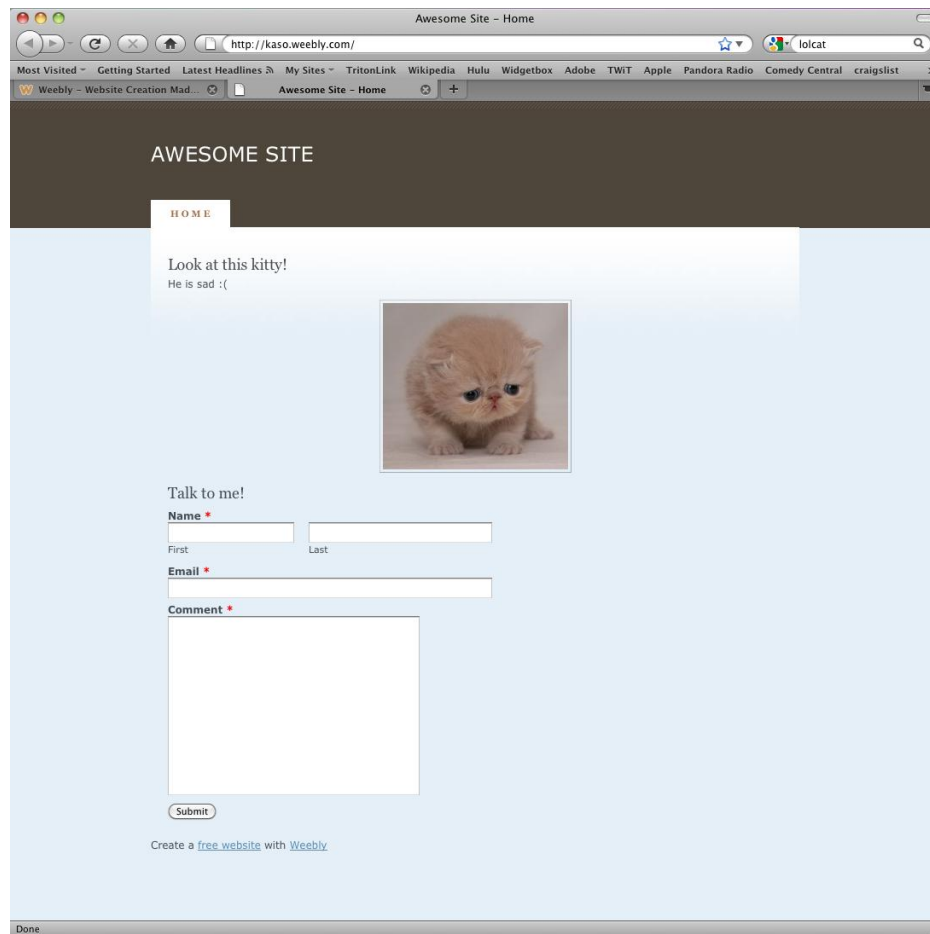
Clicking the "Settings" tab at the top gives options to adjust your site's title, address and domain name, the site's footer message, and even add a password to your site to restrict access.



When your all done creating your site, click the orange "Publish" button in the top right-hand corner. A popup box will appear confirming that your site is up and ready to view.



Follow the link provided, and you will get a glimpse of what the viewer will see upon coming to your new site.
