

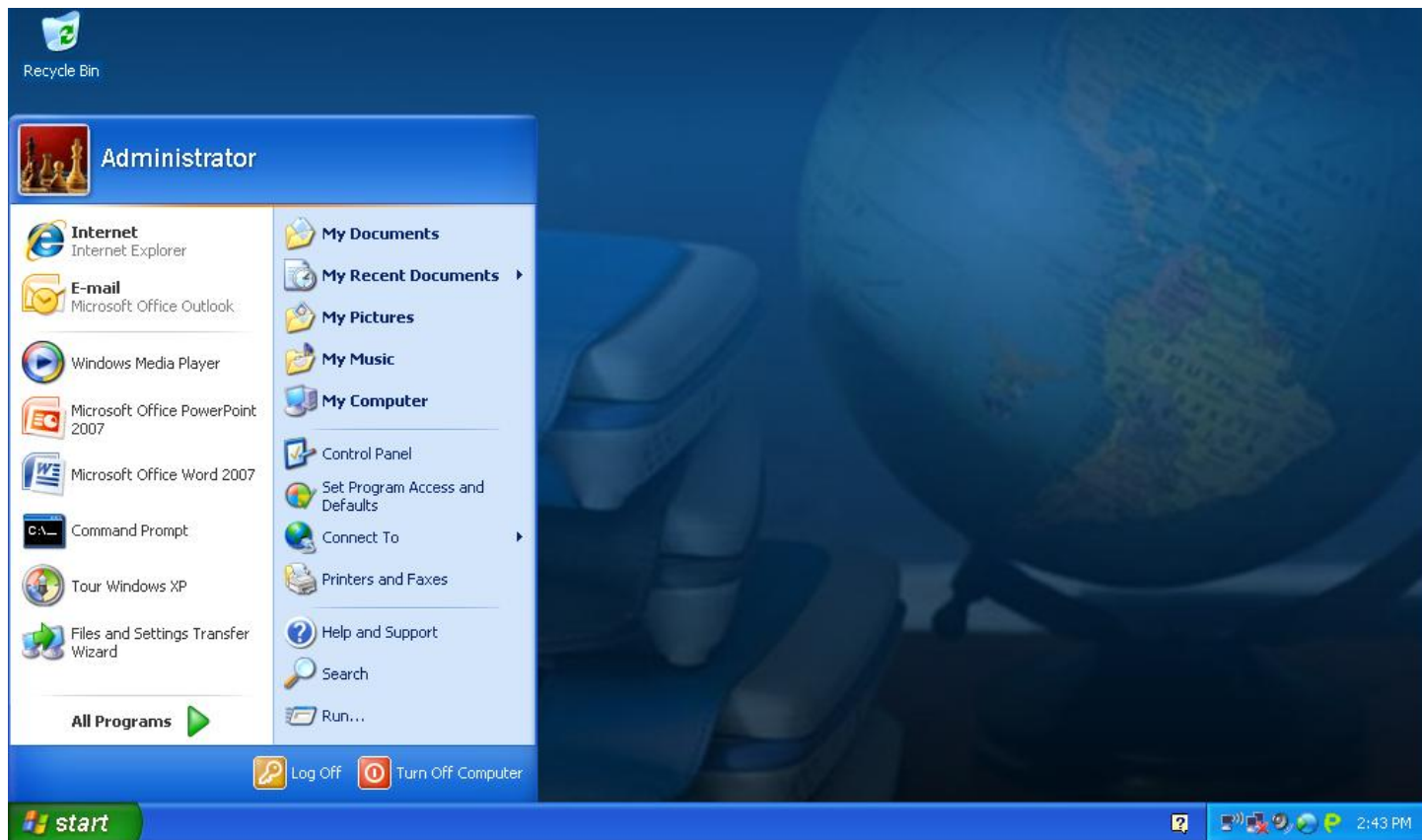
# Installing Firefox on Windows XP

# Opening Internet Explorer

- Click on the start menu and select Internet Explorer



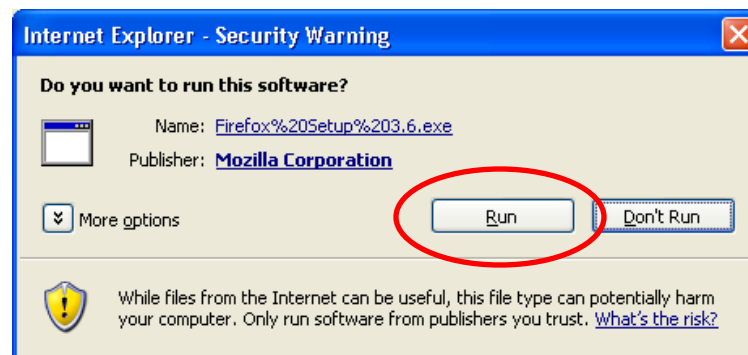
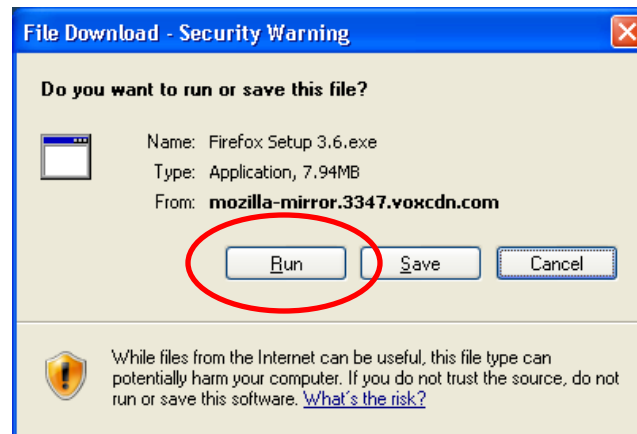
# Starting Firefox Download

- Type the address [www.firefox.com](http://www.firefox.com) into the browser and hit Enter. Click on the download icon circled below



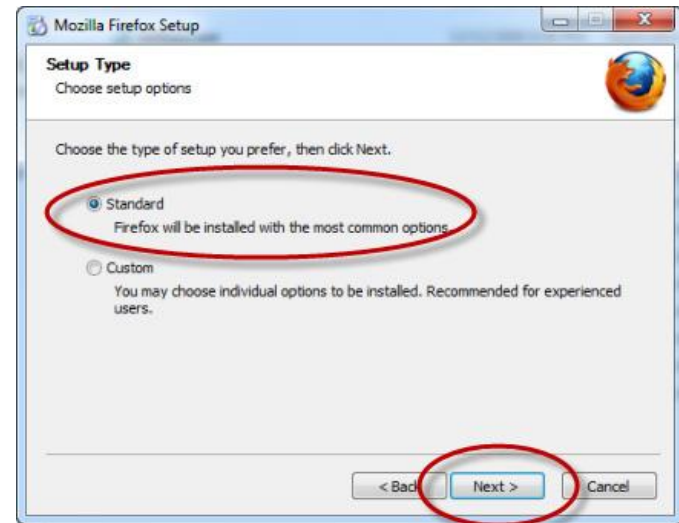
# Confirming installation

- Windows will ask you to confirm that you want to run Firefox. Click Run on the File Download – Security Warning panel. The download will finish and another security warning will come up. Again hit Run to proceed



# Installation Options

- Proceed through set up screens by hitting Next. Choose the Standard installation option as indicated below. If prompted about using Firefox as your default browser leave the check box filled in and hit Next



# Finishing Installation

- Click the Finish box as indicated below and Firefox will launch automatically



# Starting Firefox

- Firefox will now be at the top of the start menu where Internet Explorer was previously. Click on the Firefox icon and the browser will start as shown below
