

# Products and Performances

**Products** are artifacts that students create and build that show learning. Products are often completed at the end of a project and used for summative assessment.

**Performances** are demonstrations, productions, and events that students design and conduct to show learning. Performances are often presented at the end of a project and used for summative assessment.

Products and Performance		Examples
Products	Report	Historical research, scientific research, journal article for publication, policy recommendation
	Design	Product design, home design, building or school design blueprints
	Construction	Model, machine, exhibit, diorama
	Essay	Letter to the editor, guest column for local newspaper or community publication, book or movie review, story writing
	Artistic Expression	Pottery, sculpture, poetry, fine art, cartoon, mural, collage, painting, song writing, movie script
	Print Media	Book, pamphlet, brochure, nature trail guide, self-guided walk through community history, poster, scrapbook, training manual, animation/cartoon
	Multimedia	Video, photo journal, slideshow, digital book, wiki, commercial, informational kiosk, public service announcement
Performances	Presentation	Persuasive proposal, inspiring speech, debate, informative lecture, research analysis and conclusion, newscast
	Skill Demonstration	Science laboratory process, specific sports skills, teaching or mentoring younger students, on-demand tasks
	Artistic/Creative Performance	Interpretive dance, play, skit, character study, docudrama, readers' theater, radio play, podcast
